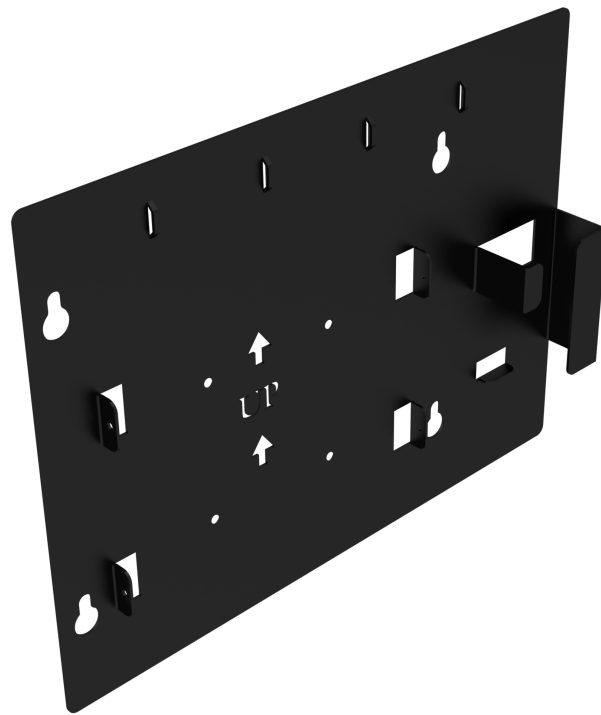

# MP600 Wall Mount Bracket

## Introduction

The Wall Mount Bracket kit provides a solution for mounting the NCR MP600 Media Player to a wall.

Before installing this kit, consider the following:

- The wall bracket is designed to be mounted using four ¼–20 toggle bolts or similar, depending on mounting substrate.
- The wall bracket is designed to hold the weight of the MP600 Media Player, its external power supply, and other supporting I/O cables. No additional components or peripherals should be mounted to the wall bracket unless prior approval is given by NCR engineering.
- The mounting surface should be rigid and be able to securely hold the weight of the bracket and the medial player.
- The installer should ensure that the mounting area is clear of all electrical, gas, and water/sewer lines for safety purposes.

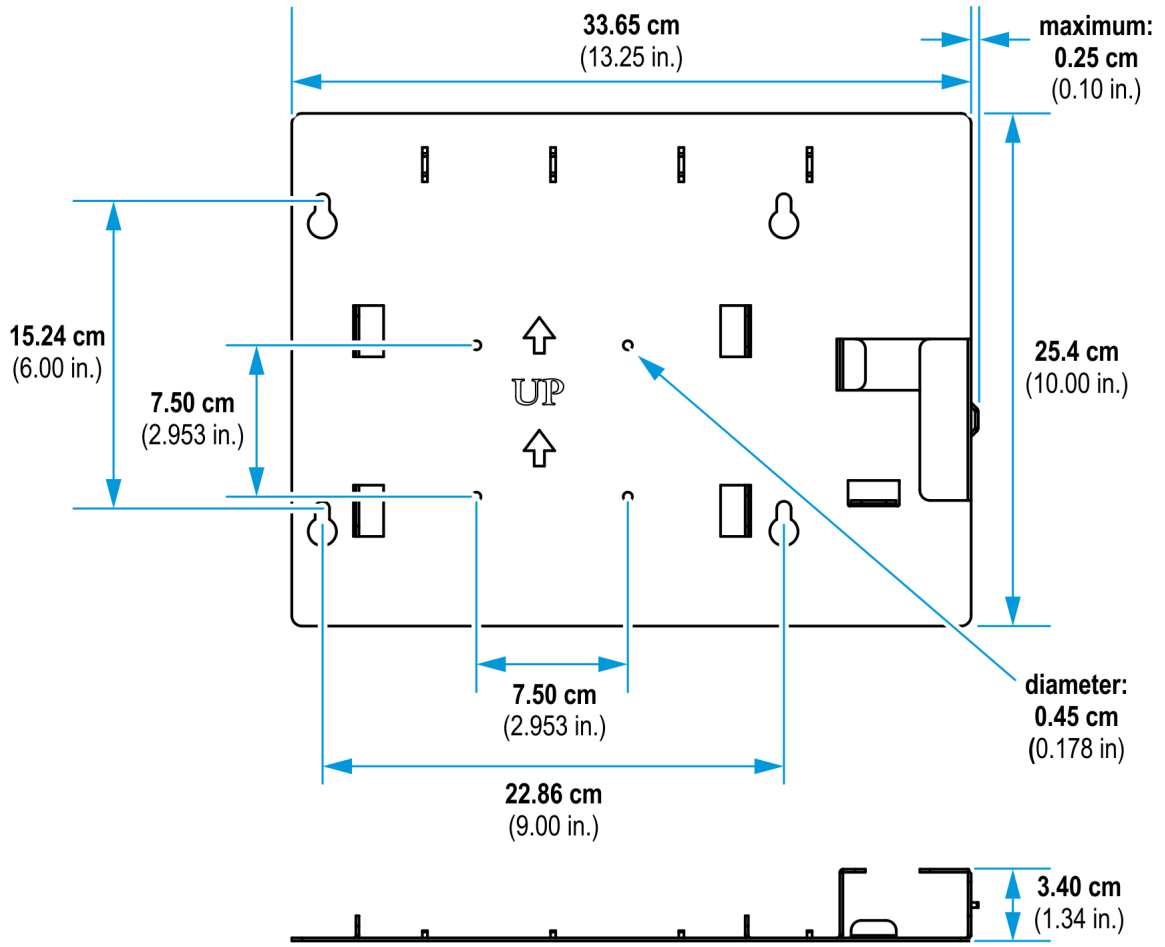

## Required Tools

- Phillips screwdriver
- Pencil or marker
- (4) ¼–20 toggle bolts or similar, depending on mounting substrate — supplied by customers
- Cable ties as needed

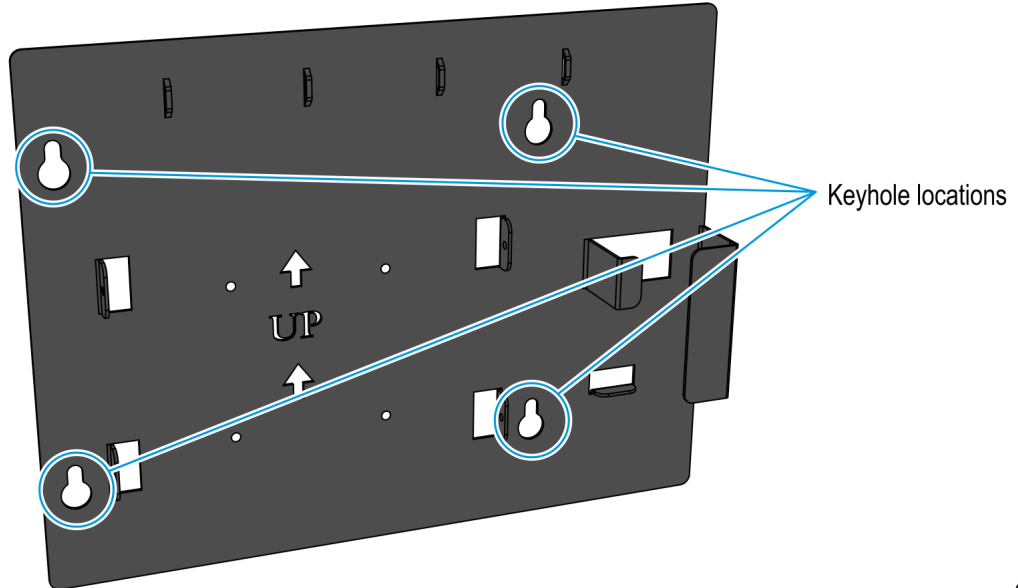
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## Installation Procedures

Installing the Wall Mount Bracket includes the following procedures:

1. Mark the screw holes and install the bolts.
2. Mount the MP600 Media Player to the wall bracket.
3. Mount the assembly onto the wall.
4. Connect the cables.

## Installing the Bolts

1. Mark the screw holes.
  - a. Using the bracket as a template, hold it against the wall and mark the four holes. Take note of the "up" arrow indicating the correct orientation of the wall bracket.
  - b. Remove the bracket and drill a hole at every marked location.
2. Install a toggle bolt in each hole.



**Note:** Leave each bolt loose to allow the wall bracket to slide between the bolt and the wall.



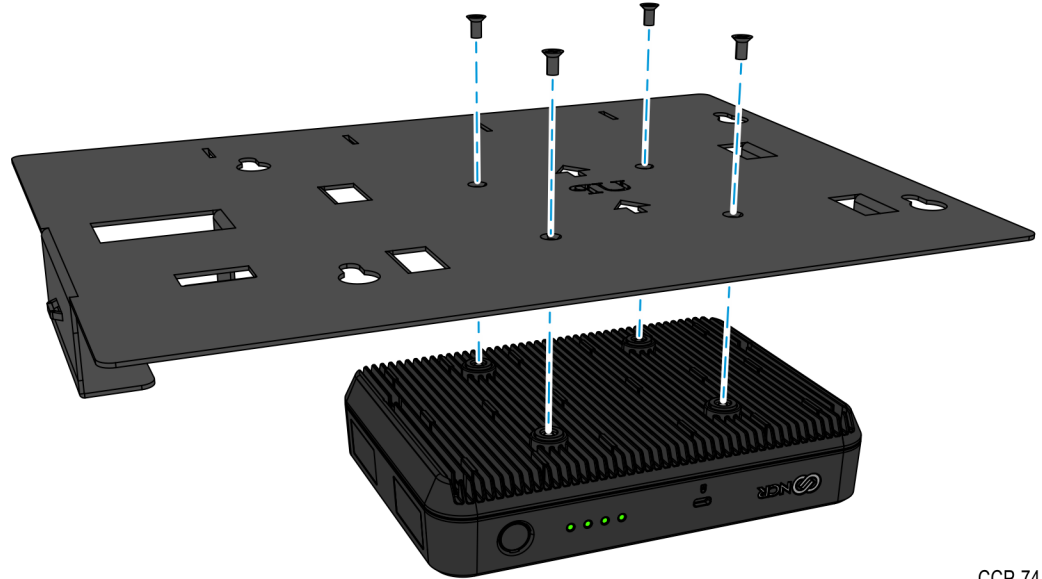
## Mounting the Media Player onto the Wall Bracket

The MP600 Media Player may be installed with the power button facing up or down (with respect to the ground).

1. Place the MP600 Media Player upside down on a smooth and flat surface.
2. Position the wall bracket as shown in the image below.



**Note:** The image shows the position of the MP600 if it would be installed with the power button facing down.



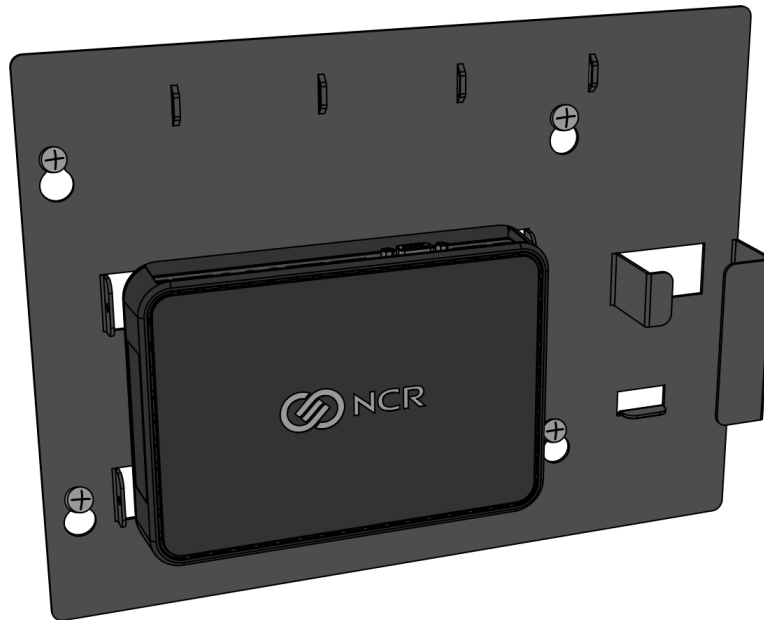

3. Align the four holes on the wall bracket with the four holes on the bottom of the MP600 Media Player.
4. Install and tighten the four screws.

## Mounting the Assembly onto the Wall



**Note:** The image below shows the MP600 Media Player mounted with its power button facing down.

1. Position the assembly (Media Player and wall bracket) on the four loose bolts.



**Note:** Ensure that proper orientation of the wall bracket is observed.

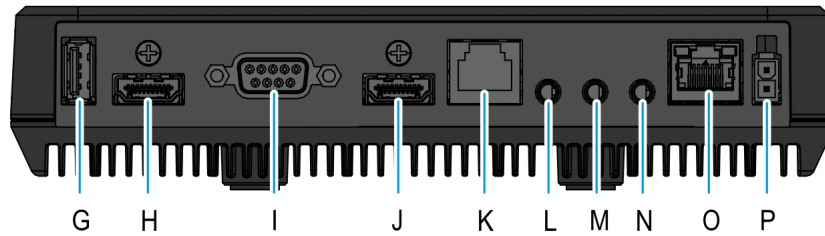
2. When the position is confirmed, tighten the four bolts to secure the assembly to the wall.

## Connecting the Cables

1. Connect the display and communication cables.
2. Connect one end of the power supply to the MP600 and the other end to the AC power source.



**Note:** If the unit is powered over Ethernet, connect the cable that provides PoE.
