Removing Existing Bagwell

To remove an existing 2-Bag Bagwell, follow these steps:

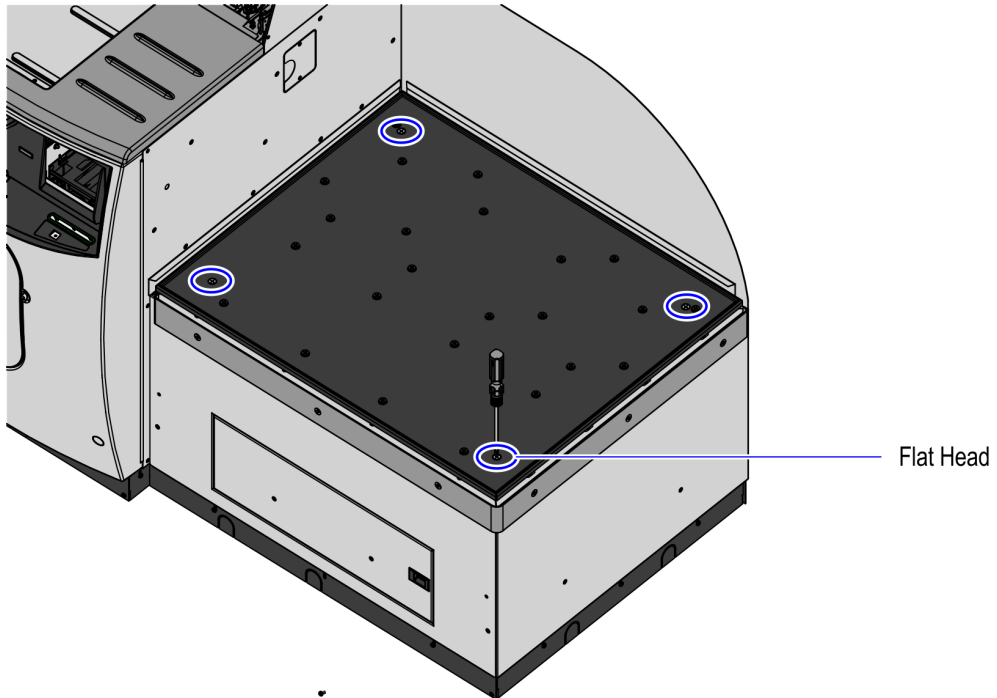

1. Detach the Scale Tray from the Bagwell by removing four (4) flat head screws.



Note: Remove bag racks if present.



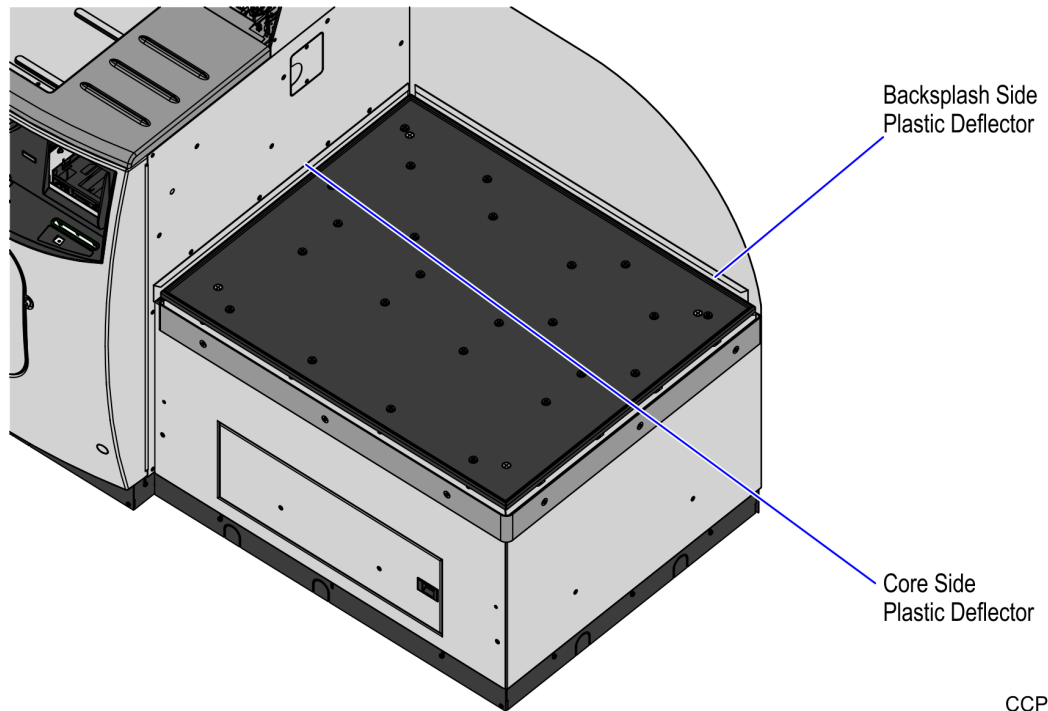
2. Remove the clear plastic deflectors from the Backsplash and side of the Core.



Note: Leave the Core side deflector in its place if the new Bagwell is attached on the same side.



Note: The 7350-K145 (Walmart Blue) variant does not have plastic deflectors and bumpers.

3. Disconnect the following cables:

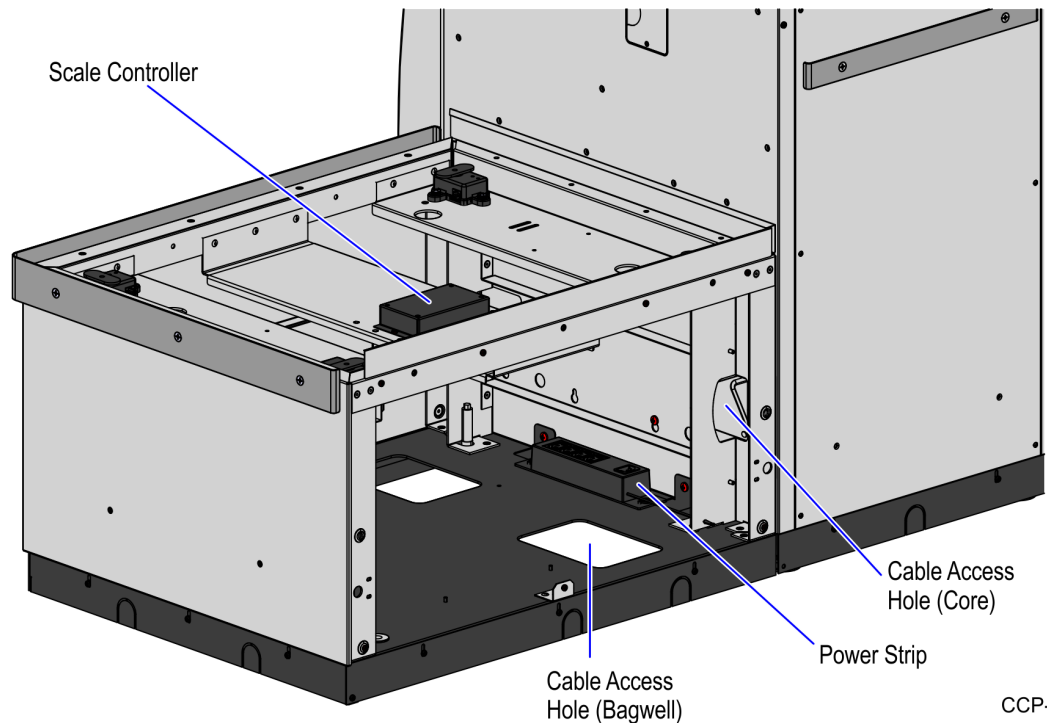


Note: The 7350-K145 (Walmart Blue) variant uses Top Spacer Brackets instead of a Scale Controller and Scale Pods.

- USB Power Cable from the Scale Controller
- Local Area Network (LAN) Cable from the Customer Interface
- AC Power Out Cables from the Power Strip
- AC Power In Cable from the Power Strip



Note: Remove cables from any routing clips or tie wraps if needed.

4. Route the following cables through the cable access hole:

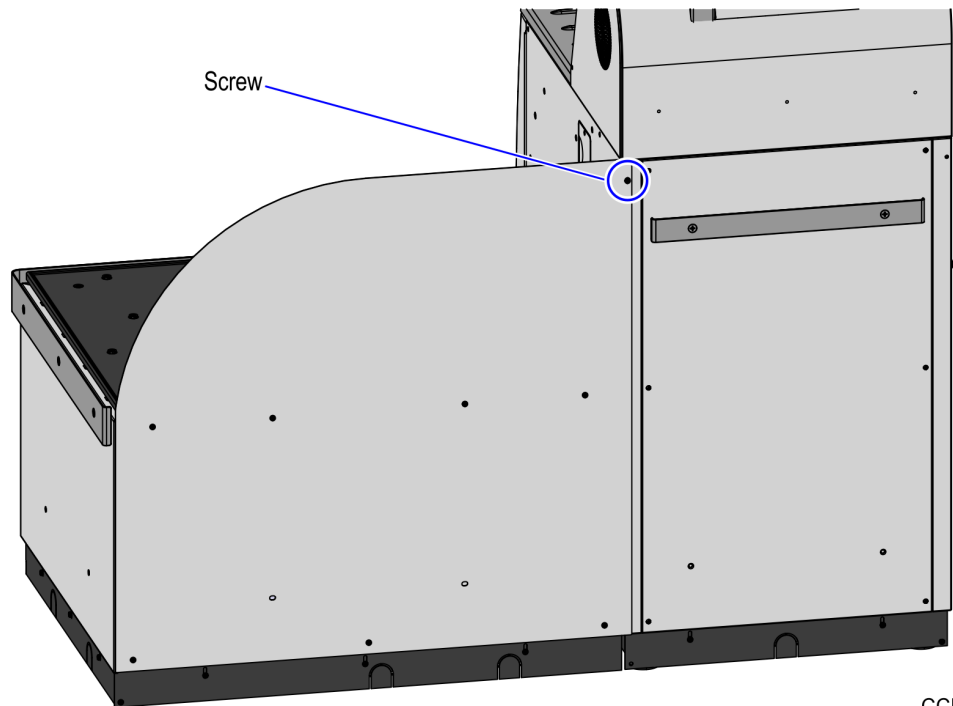

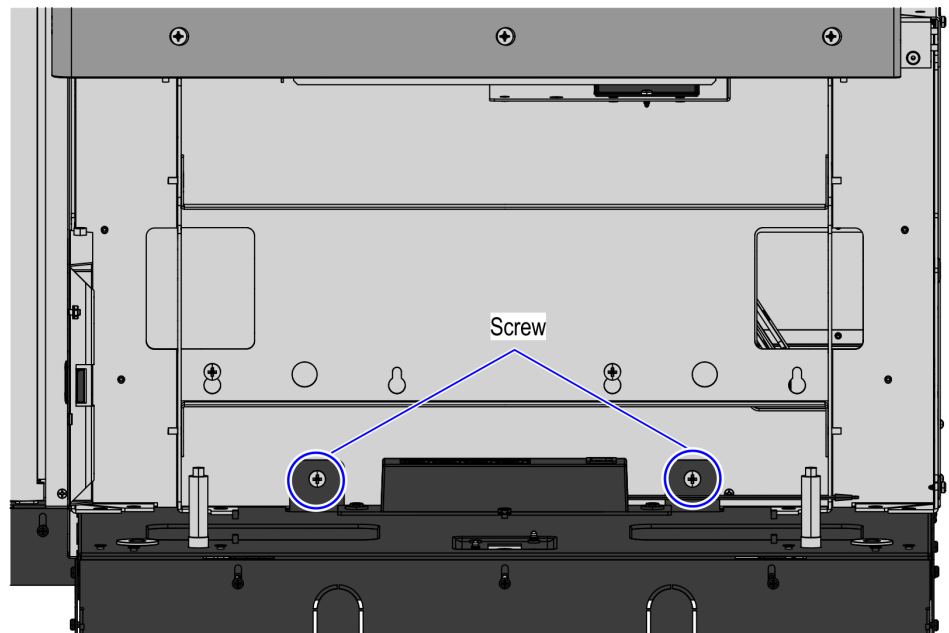

5. Remove the upper rear screw attaching the Backsplash to the Core.



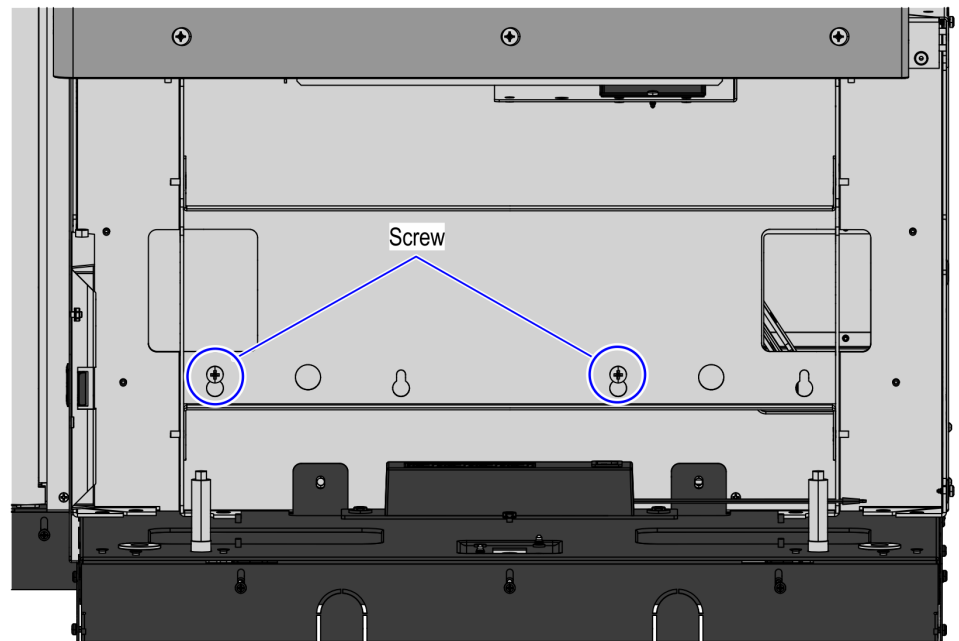

6. Remove the Bagwell by doing the following:
 - a. Remove the two (2) bottom screws attaching the Bagwell to the Core. Screws are located on either side of power strip.



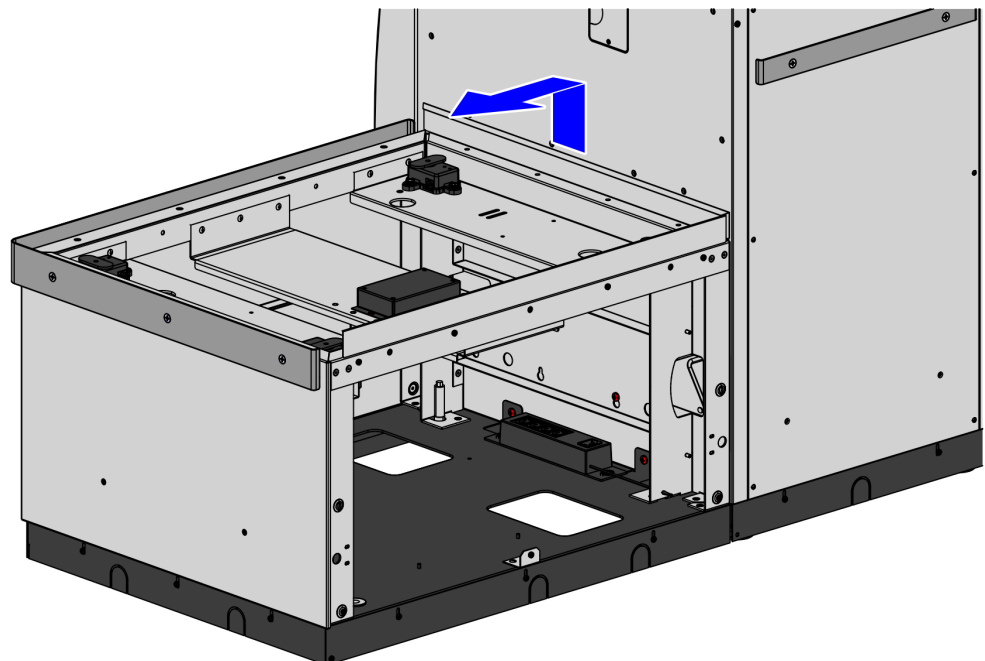

- b. Loosen the two (2) upper screws, but do not remove.

- c. Lift Bagwell up and away from Core. The upper screw heads will pass through the key holes in the Bagwell side support.

Note: The two (2) upper screws may be left in place if a new Bagwell will be installed in the same orientation. Otherwise, remove the screws from the side of the Core.

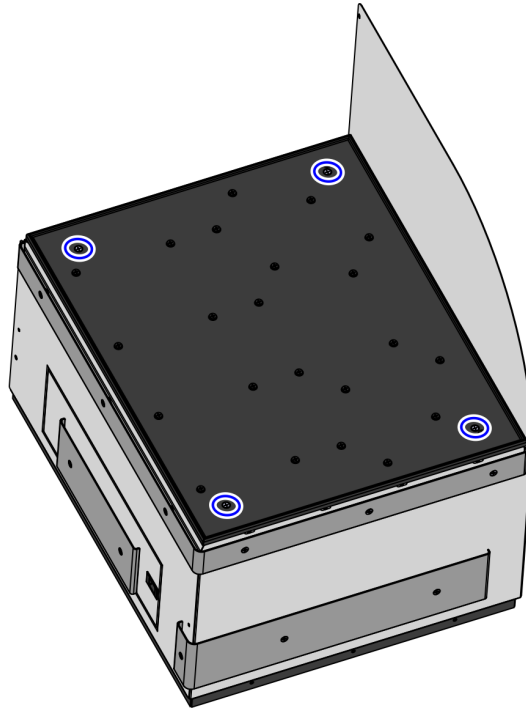
Changing Bagwell Orientation

To change the Bagwell from right hand to left hand orientation, follow these steps:



Note: These steps should be done before attaching the Bagwell to the Core.

1. Detach the Scale Tray from the Bagwell by removing four (4) flat head screws.

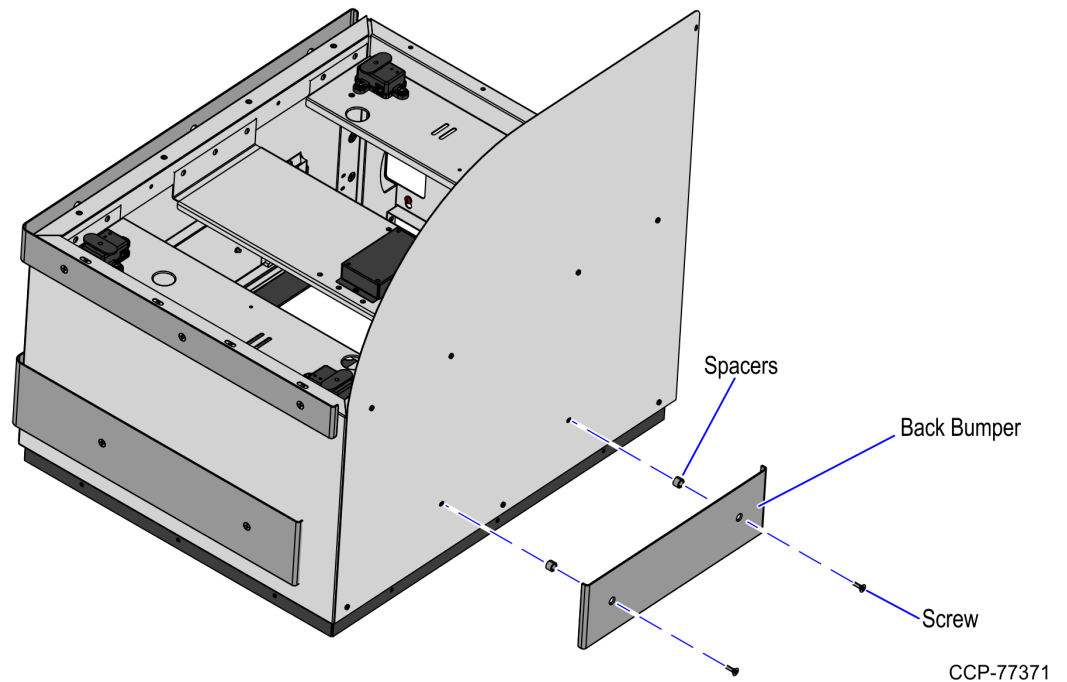


2. Remove the bumpers by doing the following:

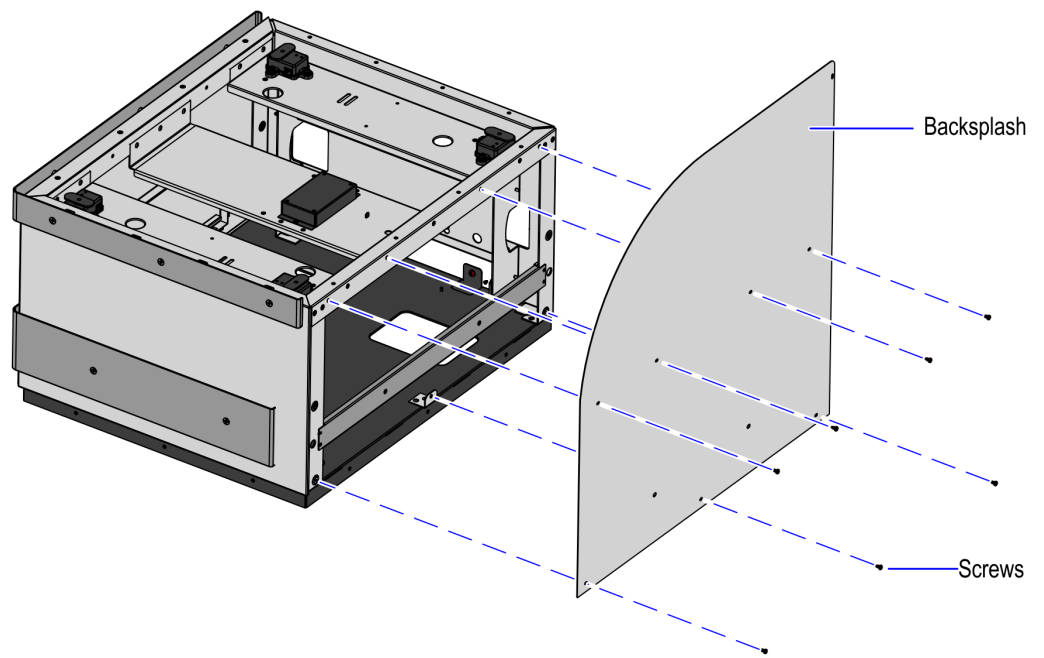


Note: Do not remove the front access door bumper

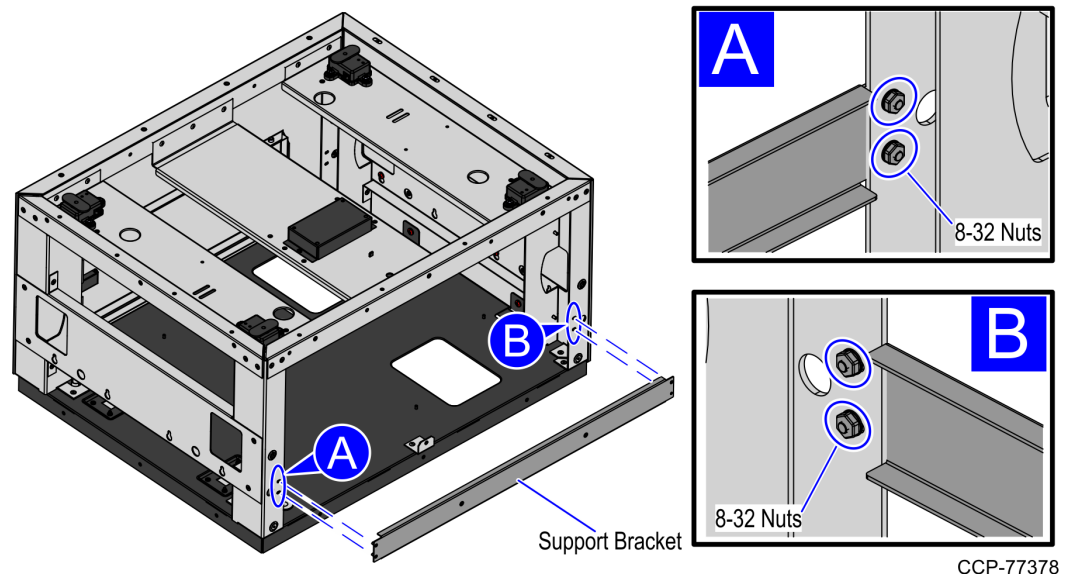
- a. Detach the lower-rear bumper from the Bagwell by removing two (2) flat head screws.



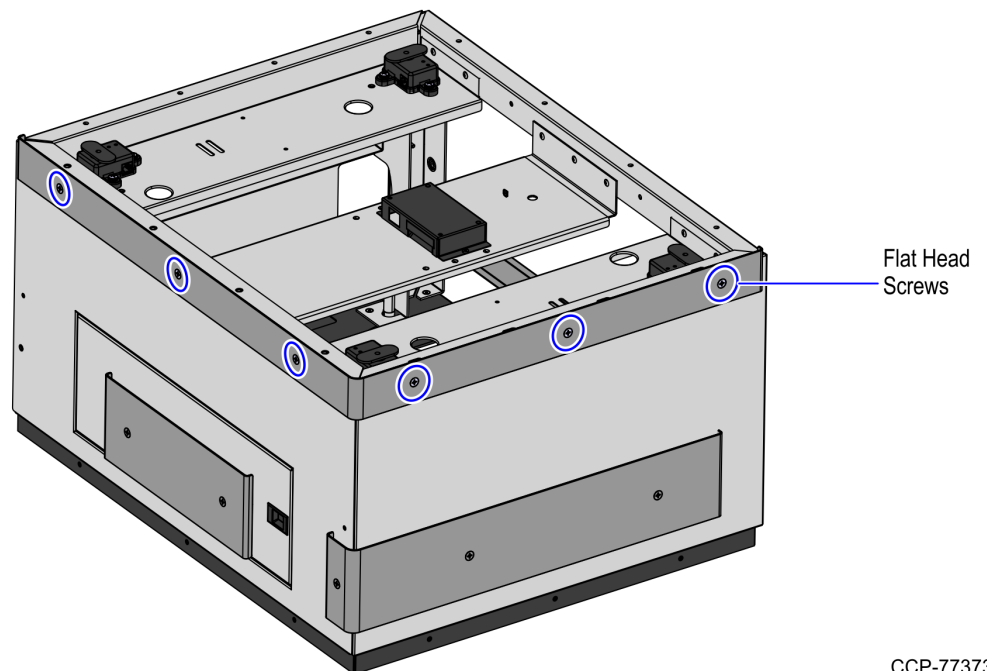
- b. Detach the Backsplash the Bagwell by removing seven (7) screws.



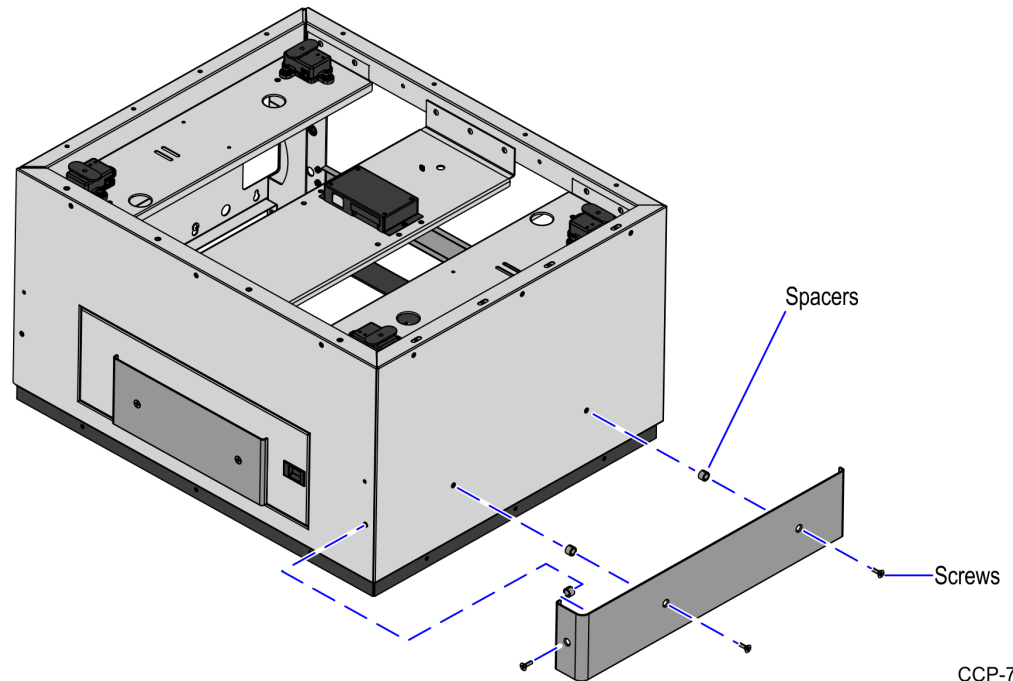
- c. Detach rear support frame from the Bagwell by removing four (4) nuts.



- d. Detach the upper bumper from the Bagwell by removing six (6) flat head screws and spacers, as shown in the image below.

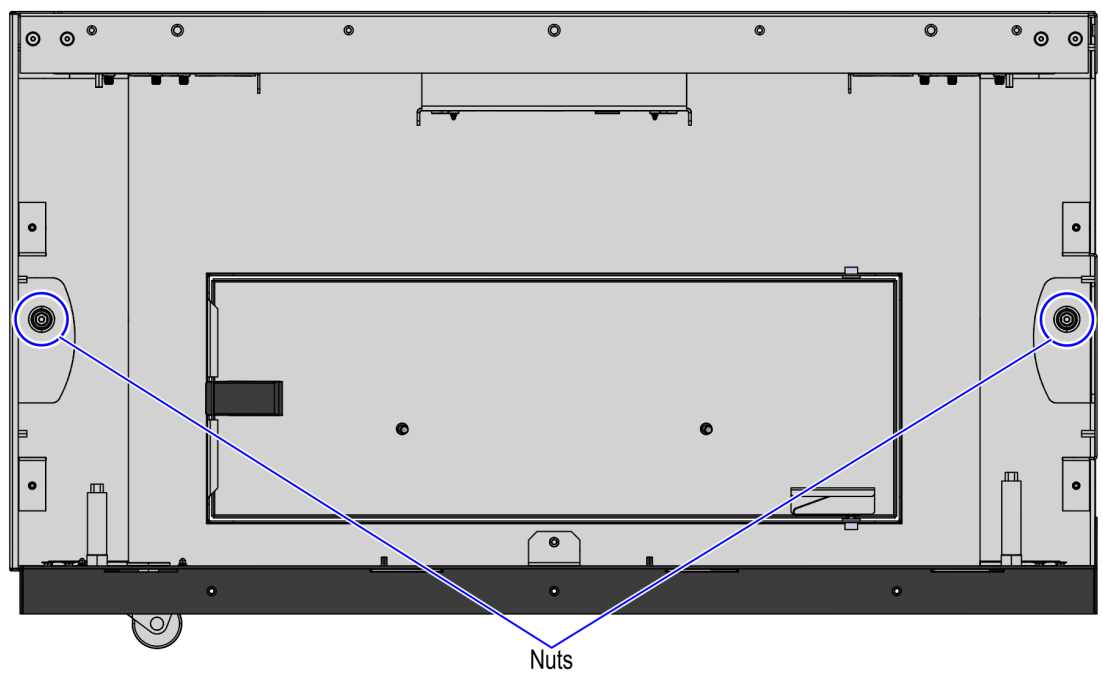


- e. Detach the wrap-around side bumper by removing three (3) flat head screws and spacers, as shown in the image below.



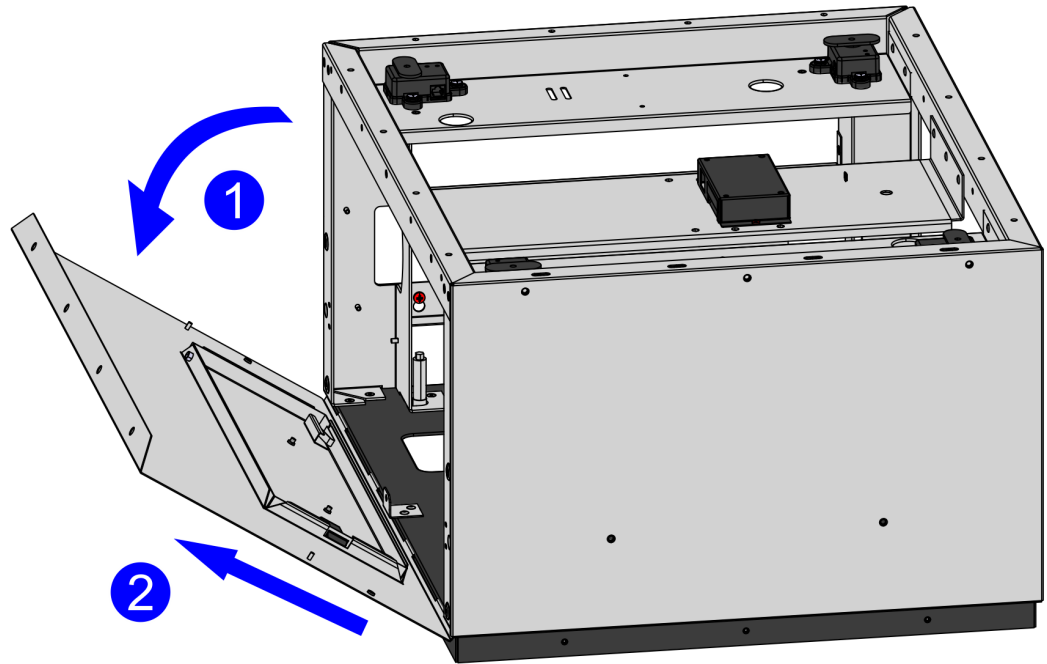

3. Remove two (2) nuts securing the front panel to the Bagwell frame located at the inside corner posts.

4. Pull down the front panel and then pull out to disengage from the slots in the Bagwell frame base, as shown in the image below.

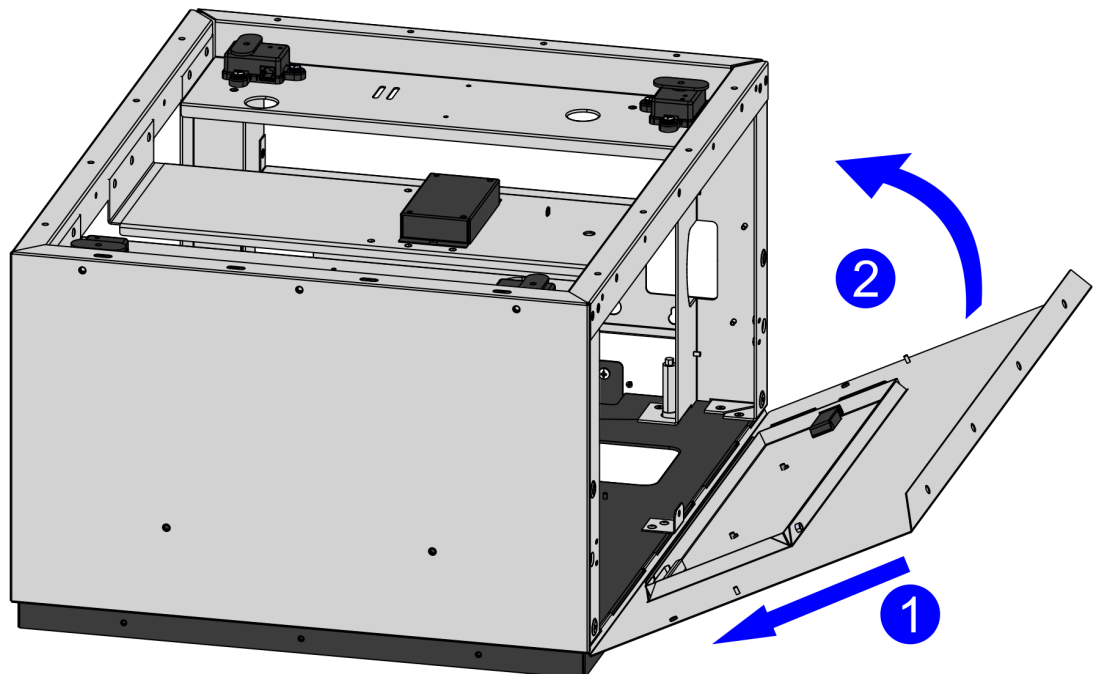

5. Install the front panel on the opposite side of the Bagwell and secure it with two (2) nuts.



Note: Ensure that the the lower hook features are properly aligned with the slots in the Bagwell frame base.



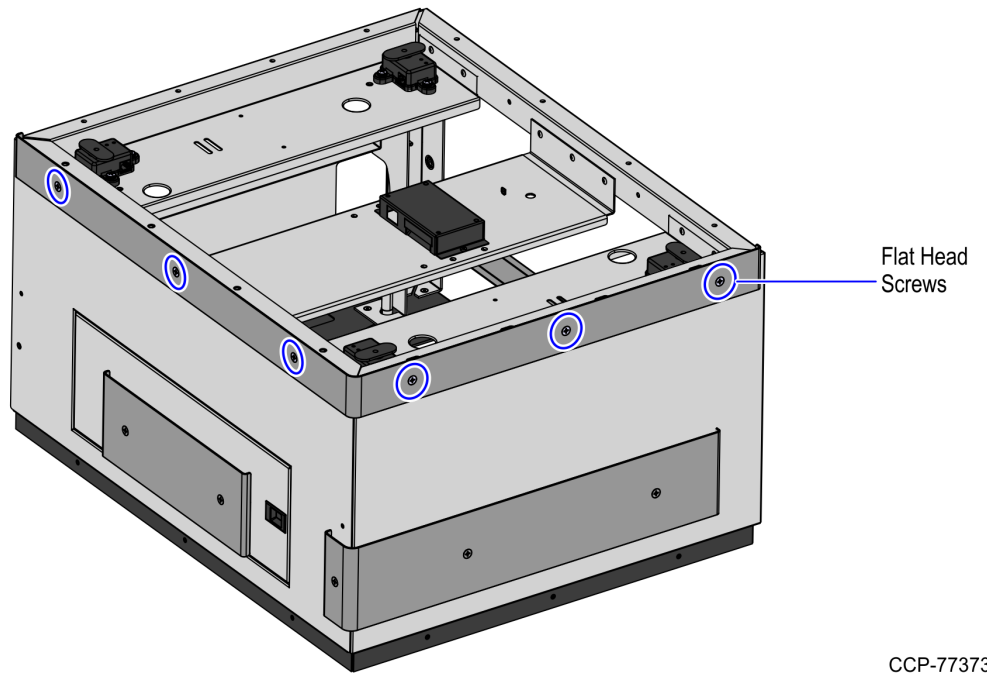

6. Install the bumpers to the Bagwell by doing the following:



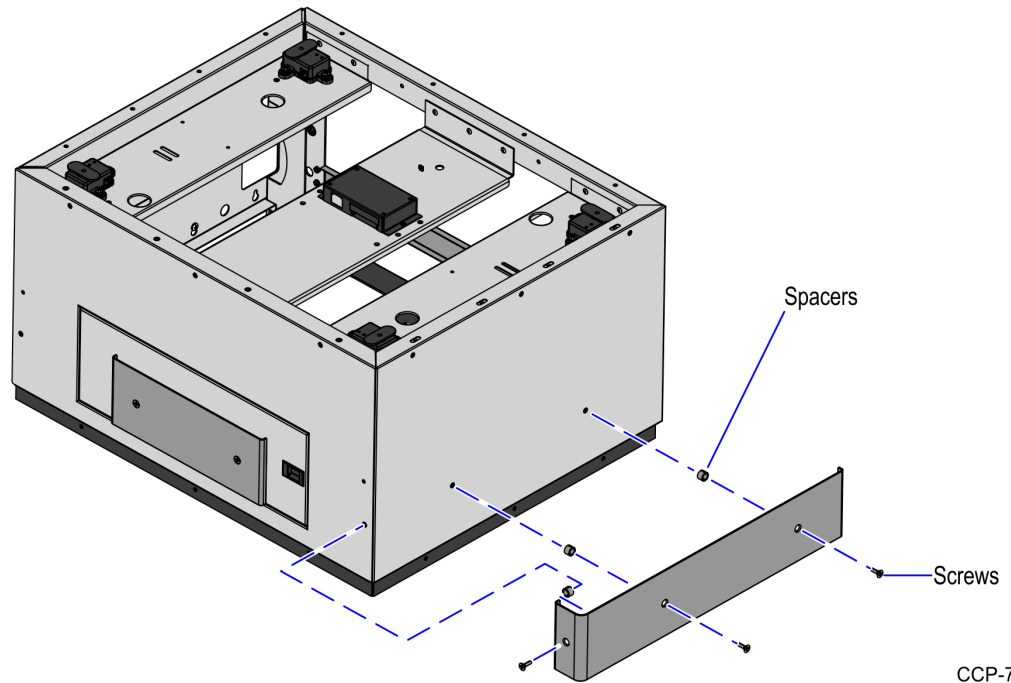
Note: Do not reinstall Scale Tray, Backsplash panel, and rear lower bumper (if present). For more information, refer to [Installing New Bagwell](#) on page 28.

- a. Attach the rear frame support by using four (4) nuts.
- b. Attach the upper stainless steel bumper to the Bagwell by using six (6) flat head screws and spacers.

Installing New Bagwell

To install the new Bagwell, follow these steps:



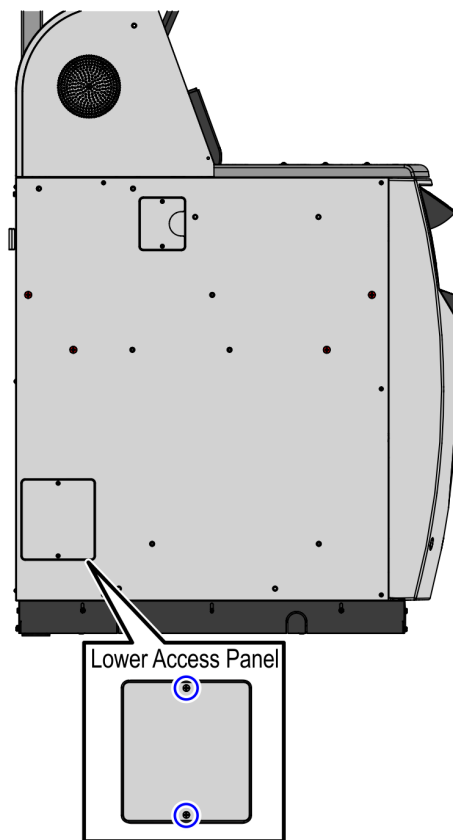
Note: If changing the Bagwell orientation (Left-Hand or Right-Hand), ensure that the orientation is changed before installing the new Bagwell to the Core.

1. Remove the Scale Tray from the Bagwell.
2. Remove the lower access panel from the Core side where the new Bagwell will be attached. Reinstall the access panel on the opposite side of the Core.

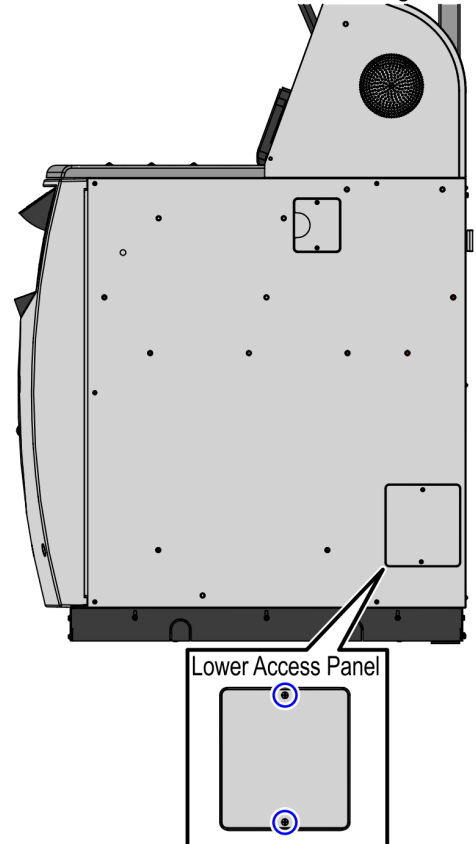


Note: This panel does not need to be reinstalled when attaching a Bagwell to a No-Bag Unit.

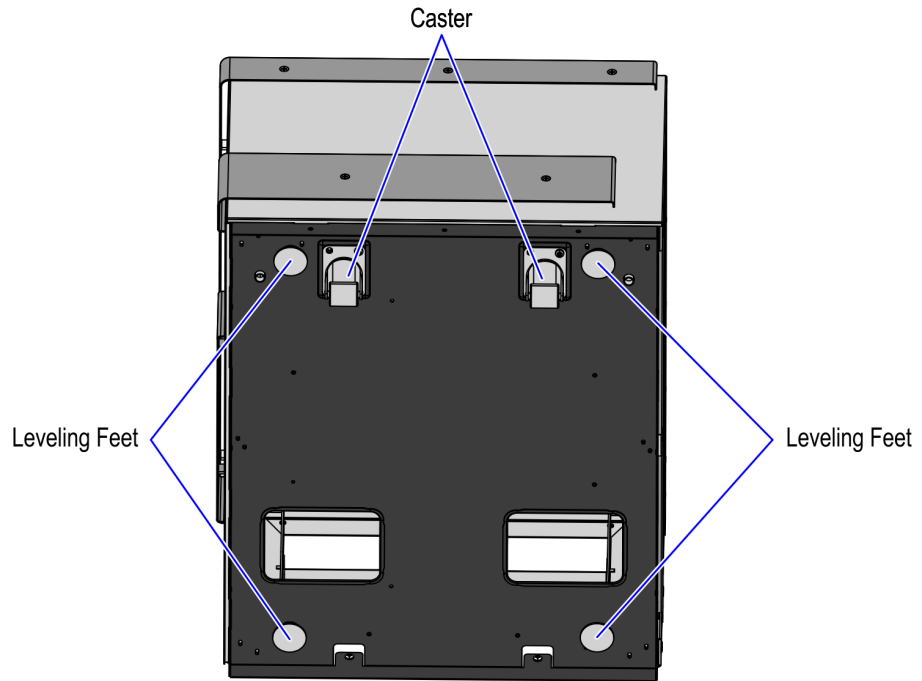
Right-hand Configuration



Left-hand Configuration

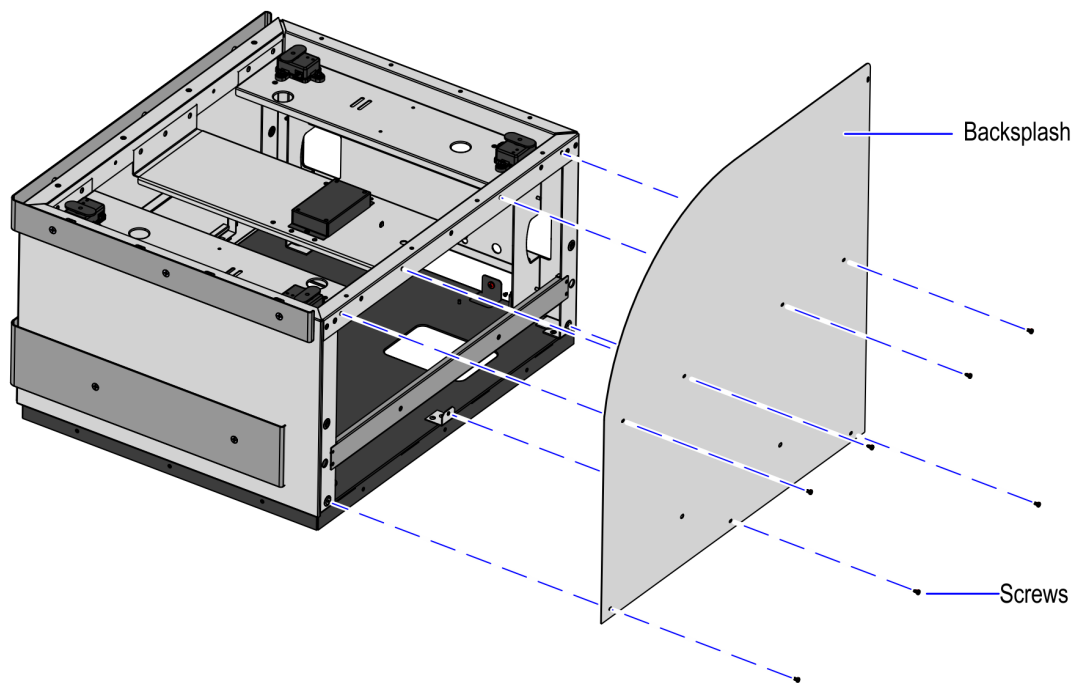


3. Lower all the leveling feet of the Bagwell slightly beyond the height of the casters to assist in lining up the Core and the Bagwell mounting holes.



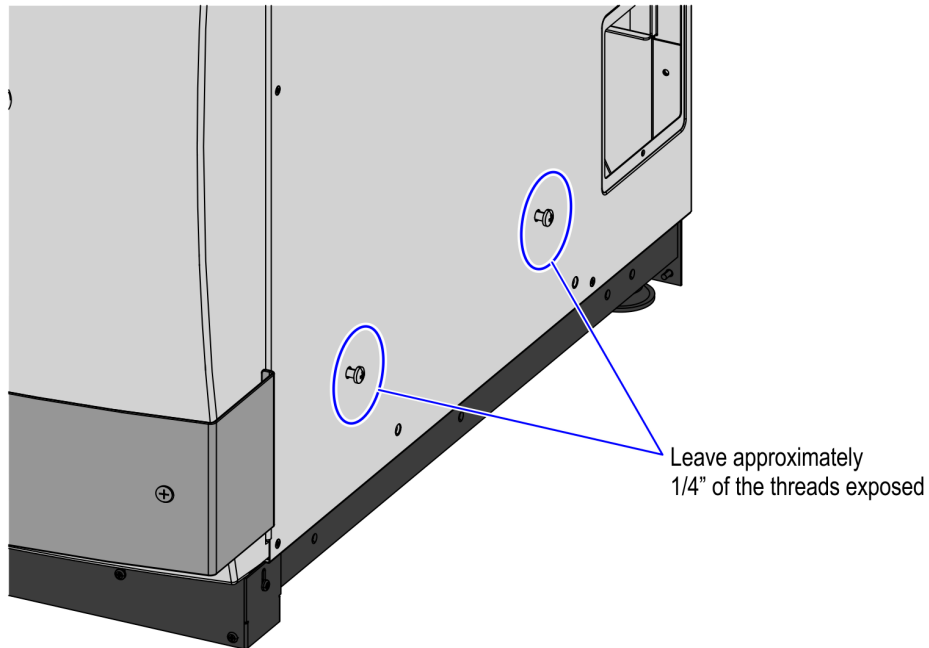

4. Install the new Backsplash panel using seven (7) screws.

5. If not already present, partially thread the two (2) upper screws on the Bagwell side of the Core. Leave approximately $\frac{1}{4}$ inch of the threads exposed.

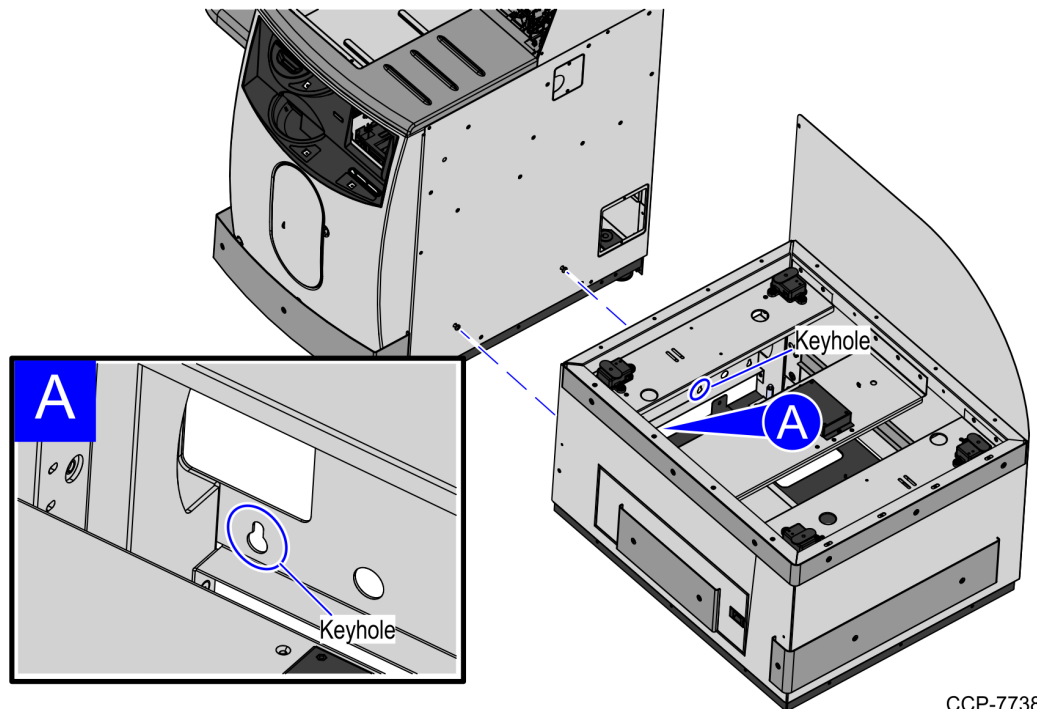

6. Mate the new Bagwell to the Core by lifting the frame up and over the partially threaded screws.

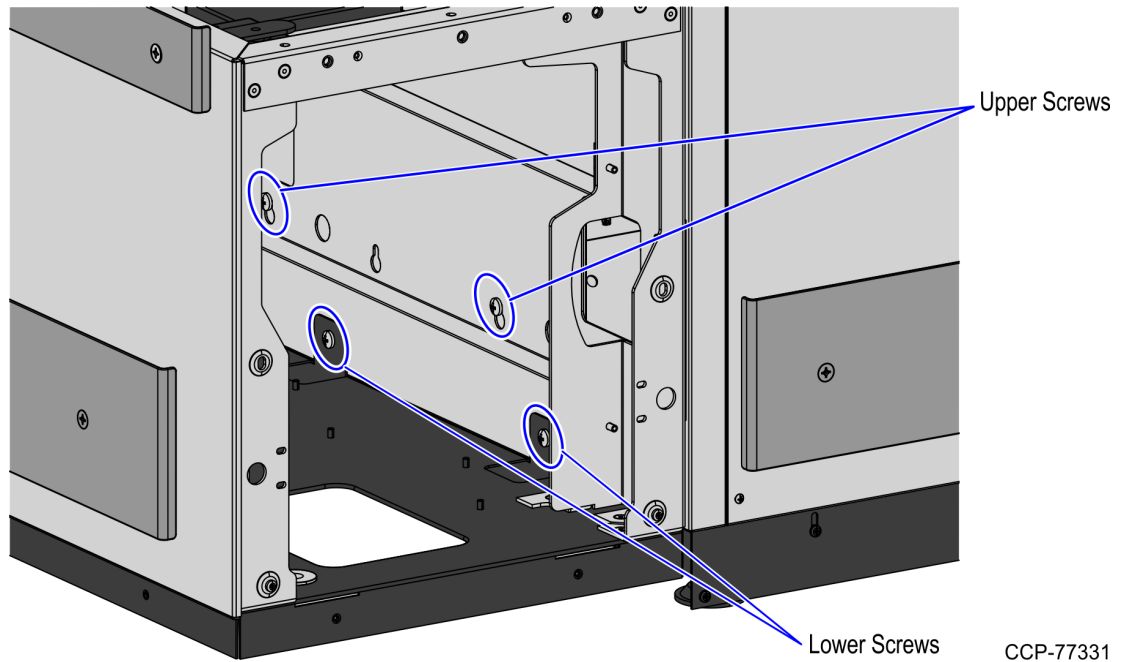


Note: Ensure that the two frontmost key holes on the Bagwell are used.

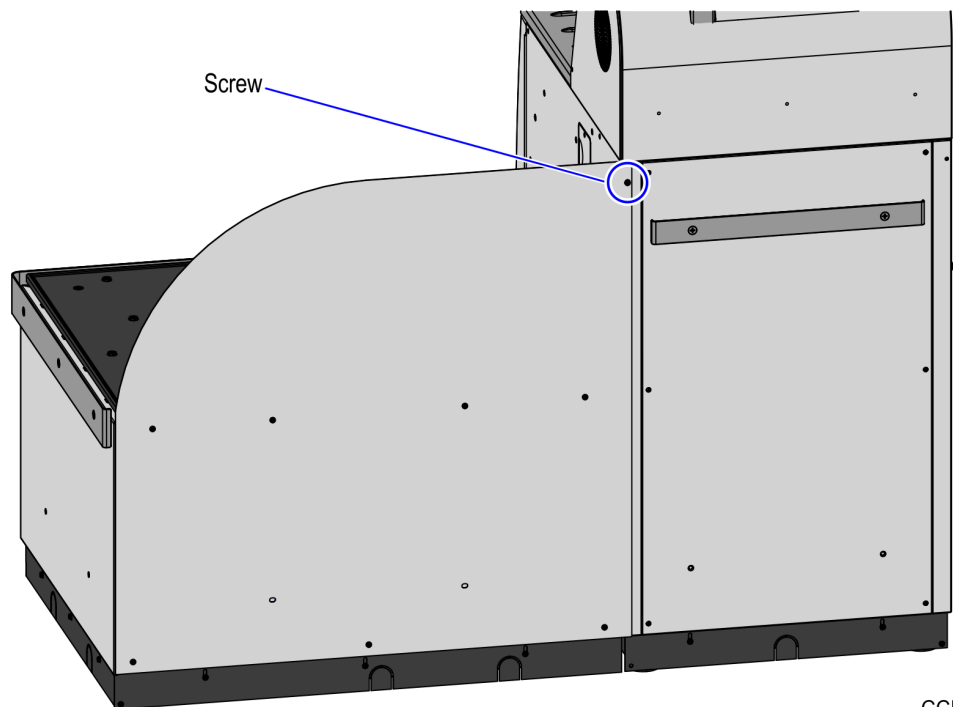
7. Tighten the two (2) screws and install the two (2) lower screws that connect the Bagwell and the Core.



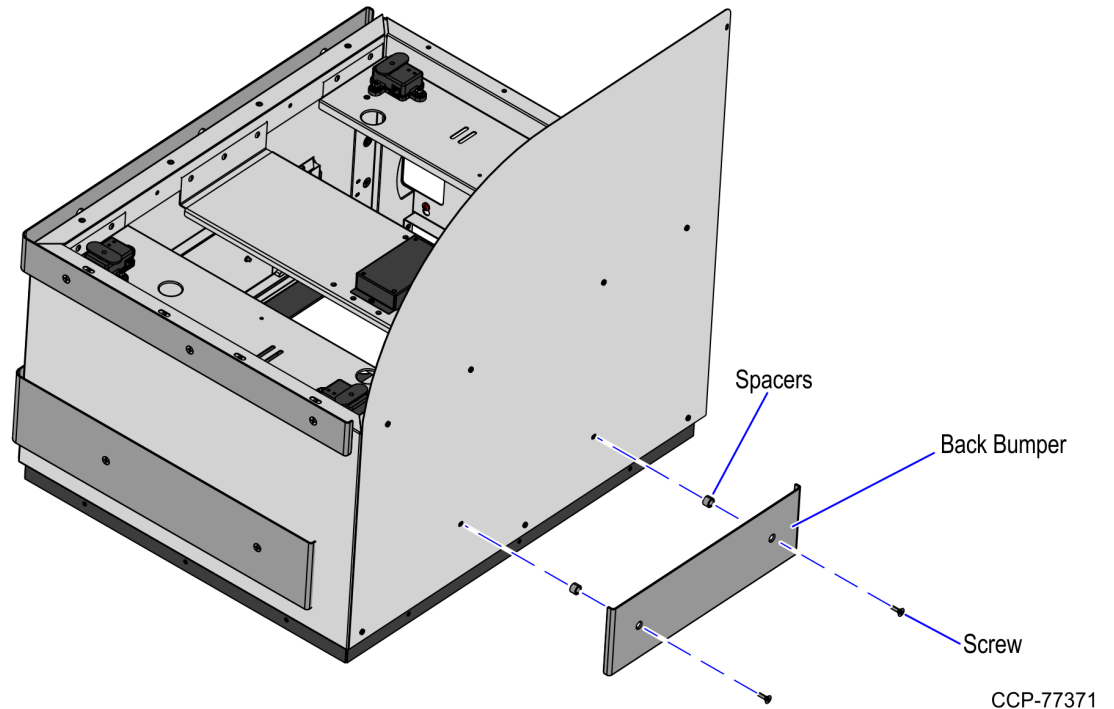
8. Install the upper rear screw attaching the Backsplash panel to the Core.



Note: Adjust the leveling feet if the slot does not line up well.



9. If present, install rear lower bumper using two (2) plastic spacers and two (2) flat head screws on the Backsplash.



10. Route the following cables through the cable access hole:

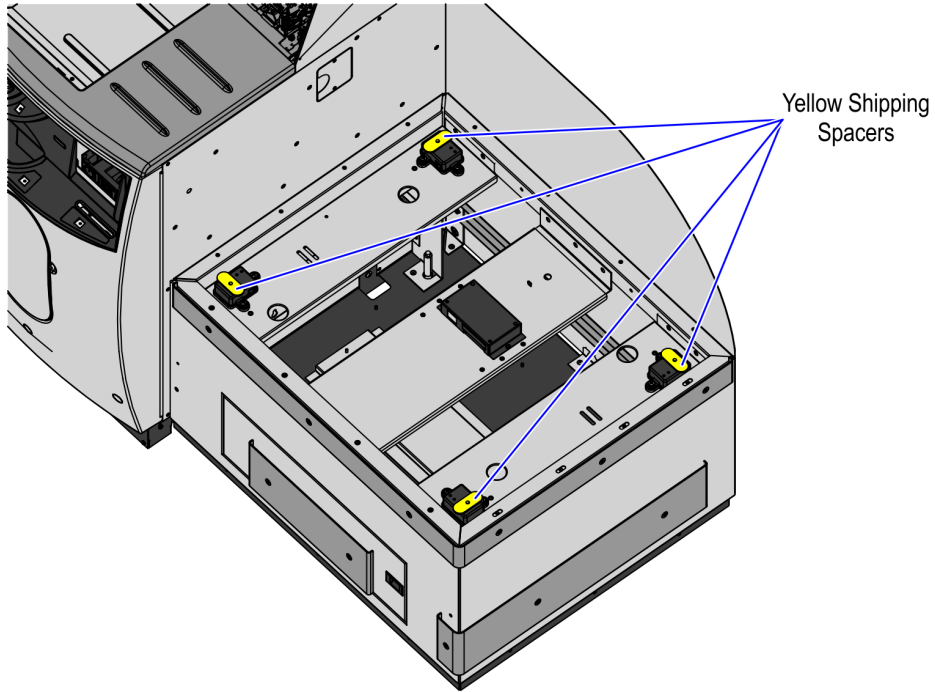

11. Remove four (4) yellow shipping spacers from the scale pods before installing the Scale Tray.



Note: The 7350-K145 (Walmart Blue) variant uses Top Spacer Brackets instead of a Scale Controller and Scale Pods.

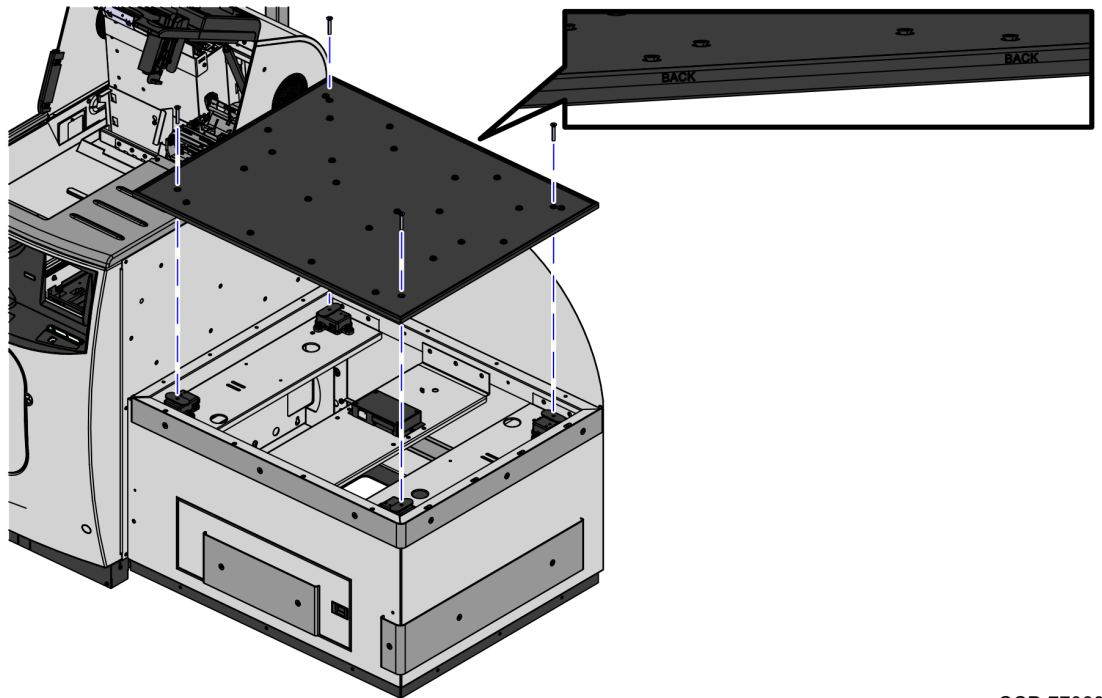


12. Install the Scale Tray on the Bagwell using four (4) flat head screws.



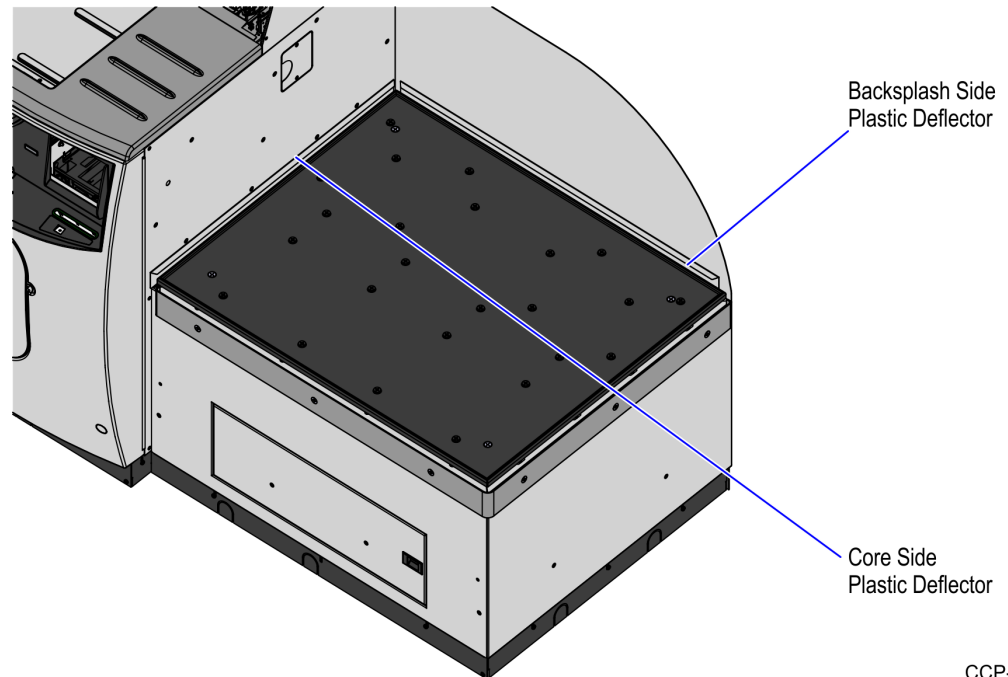
Note: Ensure that the surface marked **BACK** is facing towards the back of the unit.

! Important: Use the correct screw length. Tighten the screws from six to eight pounds. Do not overtighten the screws to prevent inaccurate scale readings.



13. Install clear plastic deflectors to the Core side and rear side of the Bagwell. Ensure that the deflectors meet at the rear and Core side corners, and should rest against the Bagwell frame.

! Important: Plastic deflectors must **not** touch the Scale Tray surface to avoid scale errors.



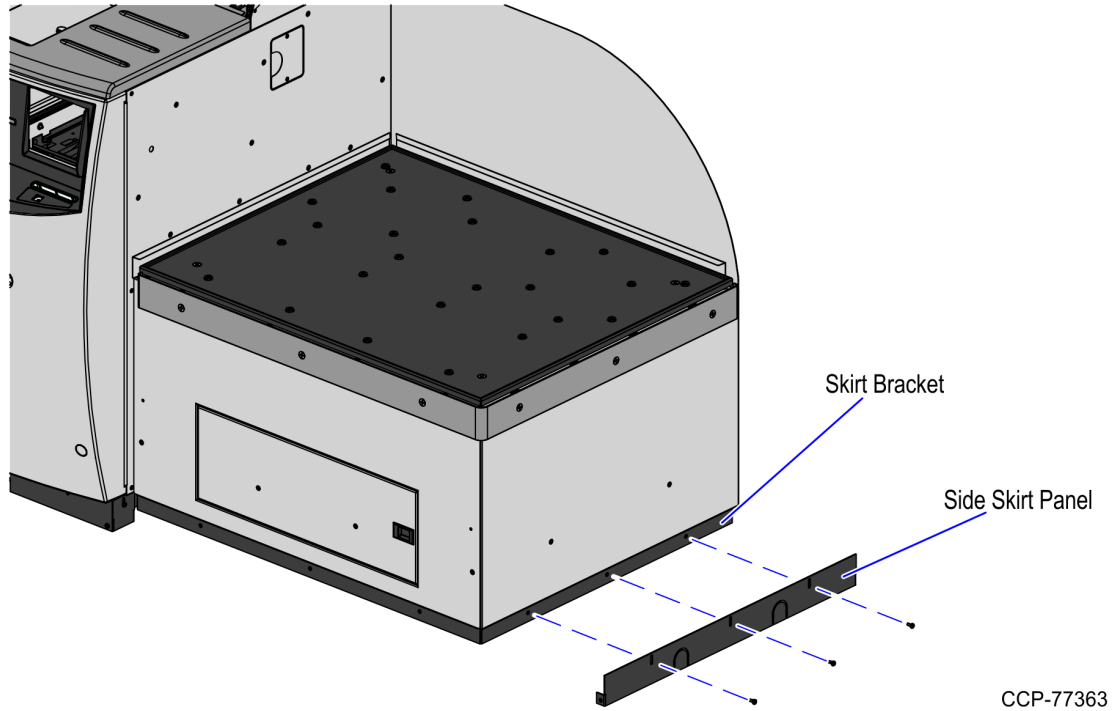

Installing Bagwell Skirt Panels

To install Bagwell skirt panels, follow these steps:

1. On the side of the Bagwell, do the following:



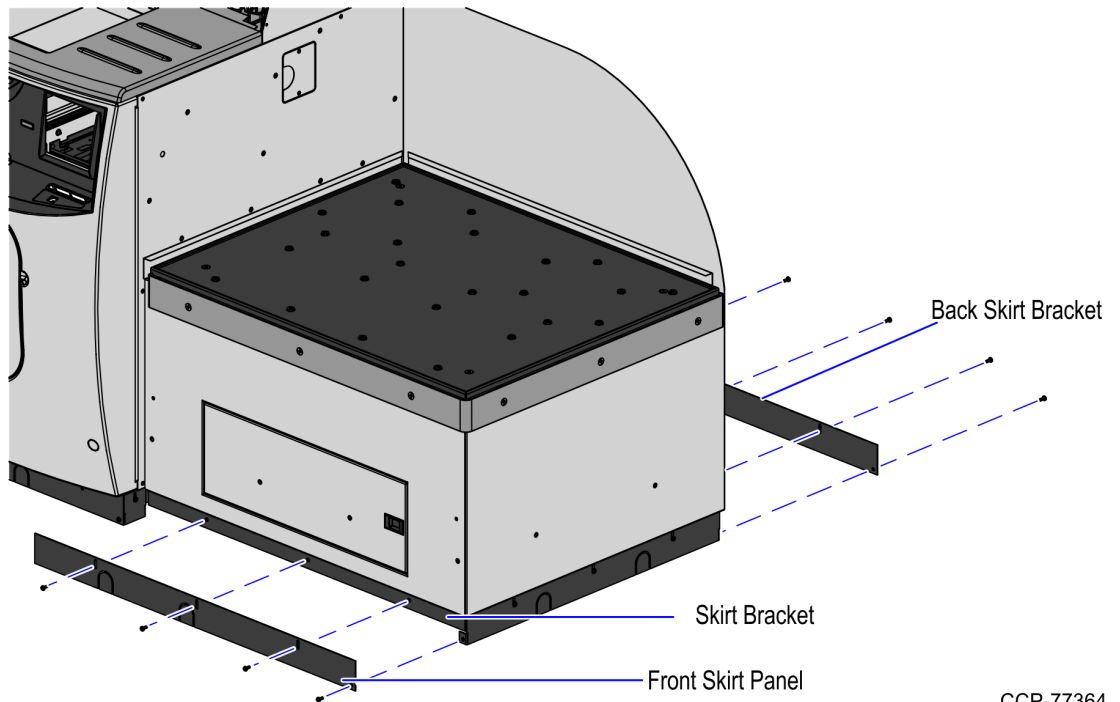

- a. Attach the skirt panel to the skirt brackets by aligning the open slots in the skirt panel with the screw holes in the skirt bracket.
- b. Secure the skirt panel to the bracket using three (3) screws.
- c. Adjust the skirt panel so that it is flush with the floor.
- d. Tighten the screws to secure the skirt in place.

2. On the front and back of the Bagwell, do the following:



Note: The front and back skirt panels of the Bagwell must be installed after the side skirt panel of the Bagwell.

- a. Attach the front and back skirt panels to the skirt brackets by aligning the open slots of both skirt panels with the screw holes in the securing bracket.
- b. Secure both skirt panels to the bracket using eight (8) screws.
- c. Adjust the skirt panel so that it is flush with the floor.
- d. Tighten the screws to secure the skirt in place.

Routing Cables

To route cables when installing a new Bagwell follow these steps:

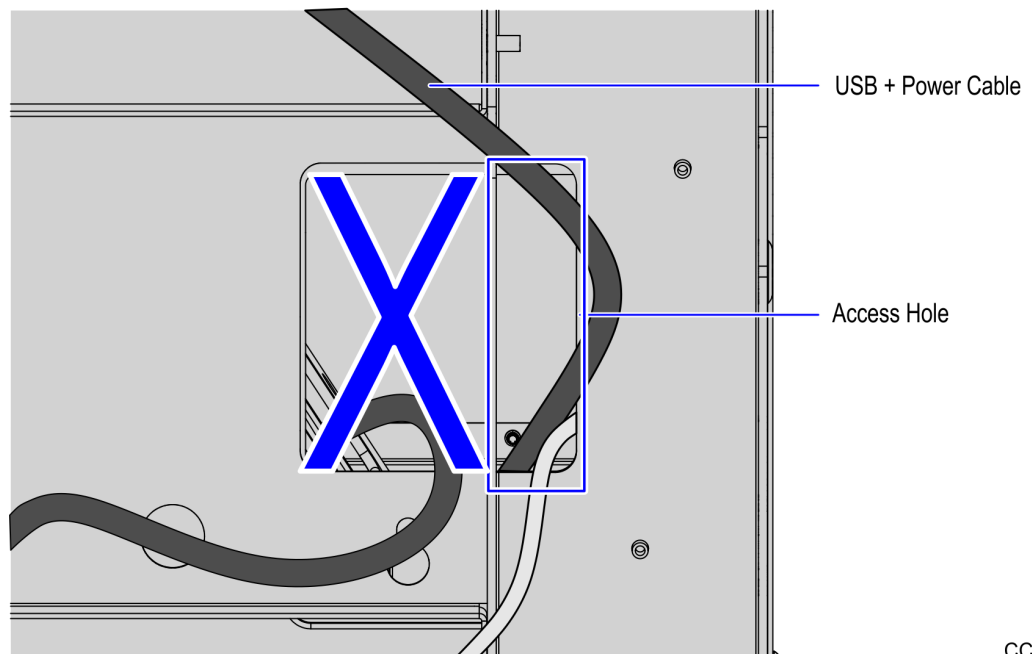

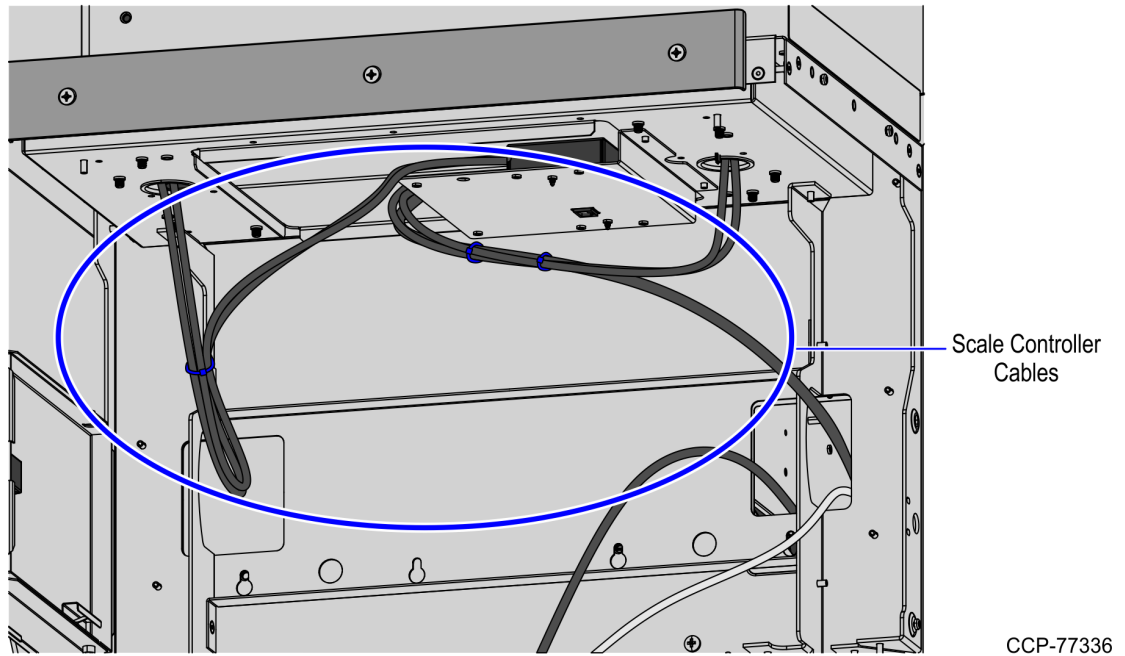

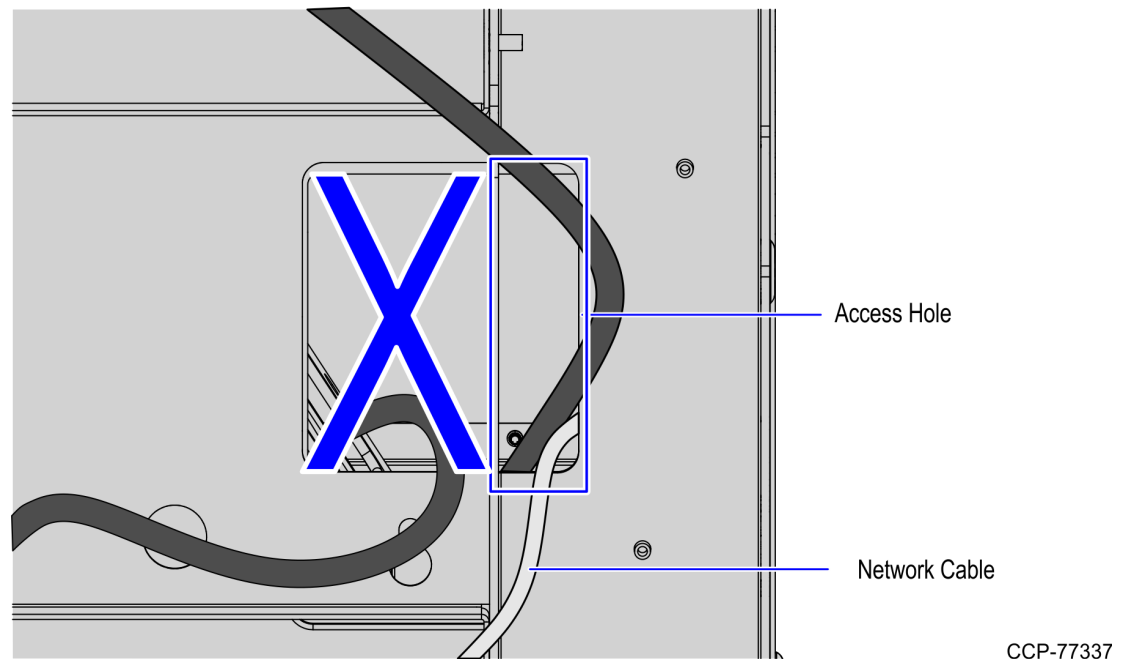
1. Retrieve the USB Power Cable from the Core and route to the Scale Controller through the smaller opening of the Bagwell frame as shown in the image below.



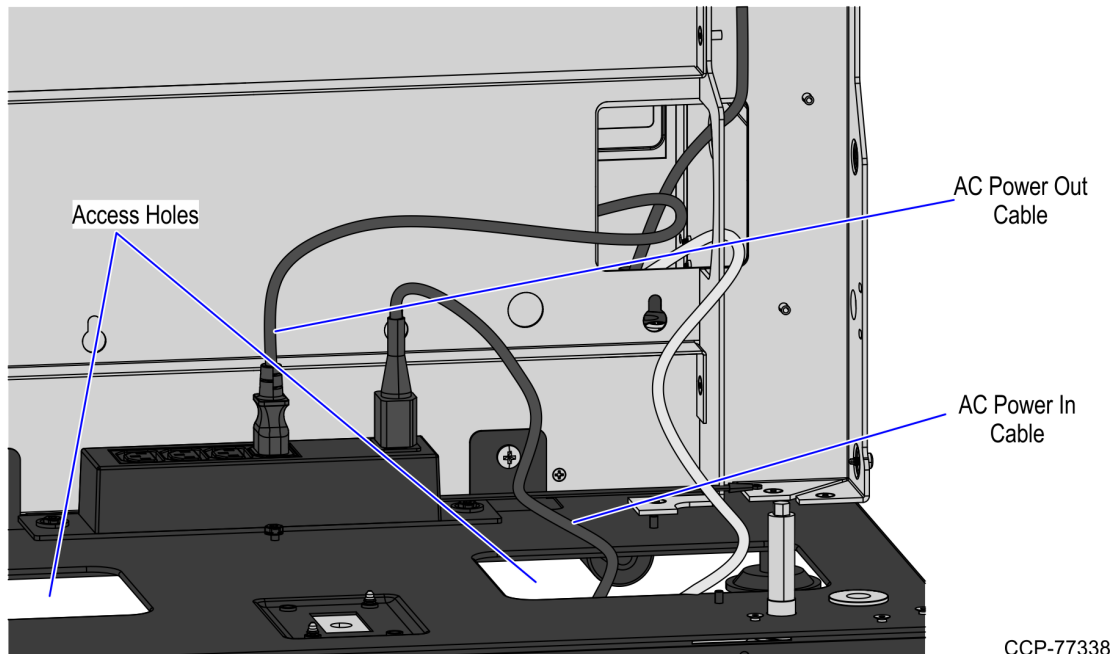
2. Tie the USB Power Cable with cable ties to hold it in place.



3. Route the Local Access Network (LAN) Cable from the Core to the Customer Interface through the smaller opening of the Bagwell frame as shown in the image below.



4. Route the AC Power Out and AC Power In cables and then connect to the Power Strip, as shown in the image below.



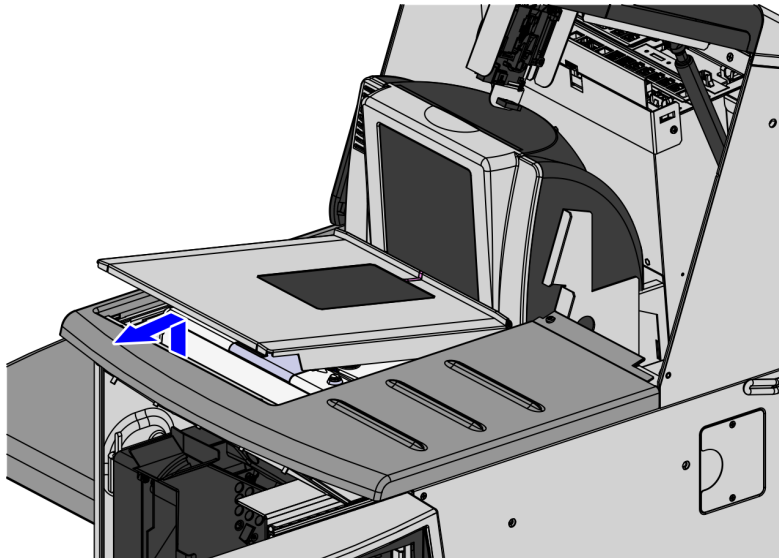
Routing Cables for No-Bag unit

These are additional steps in routing cables when upgrading a No-Bag unit to a 1-Bag unit:

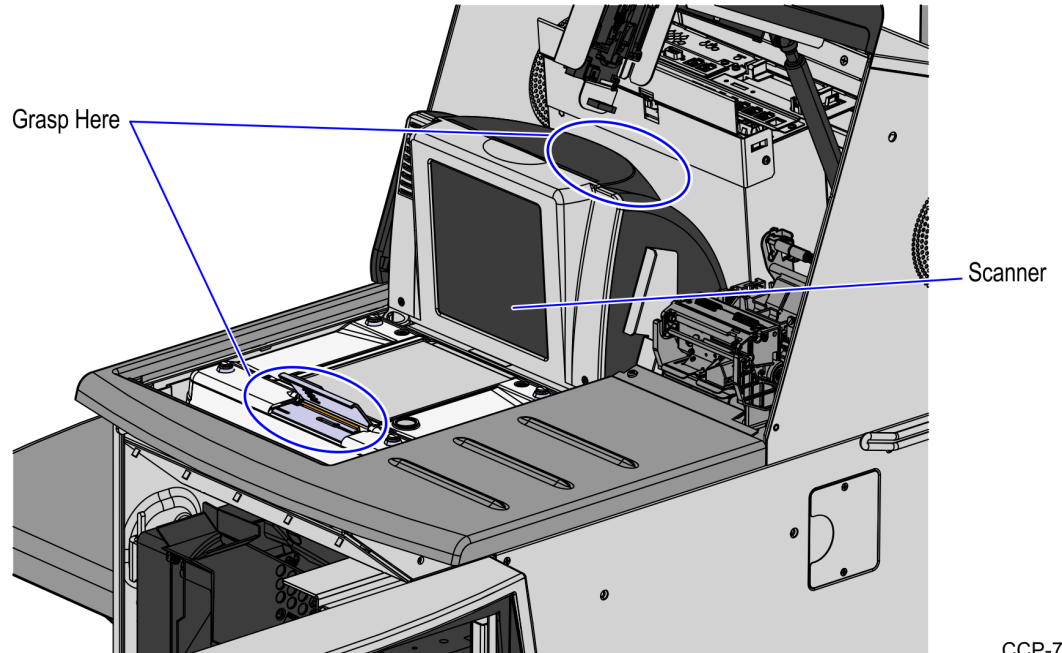


Note: Use the new USB Power Cable. Route the USB Power Cable to the E-Box first before installing new Bagwell.

1. Unlock and open the upper Cabinet Door.
2. Lift the Scale Plate from the Scanner.

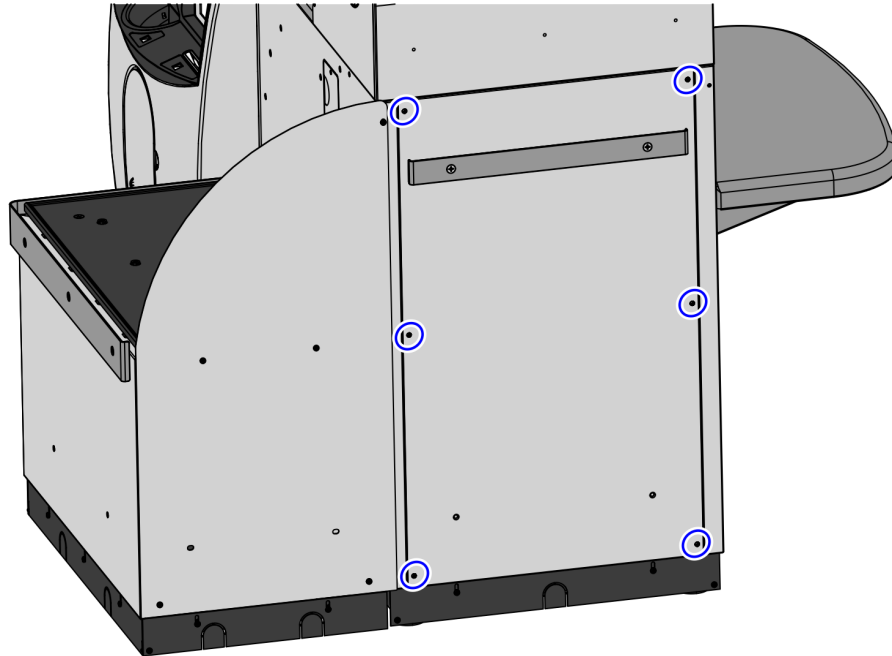


3. Do the following to remove the Scanner/Scale from the scanner bucket area.
 - a. Grasp the front of the Scanner and lift up.
 - b. Grasp the back of the Scanner and slide scanner out of the bucket area.



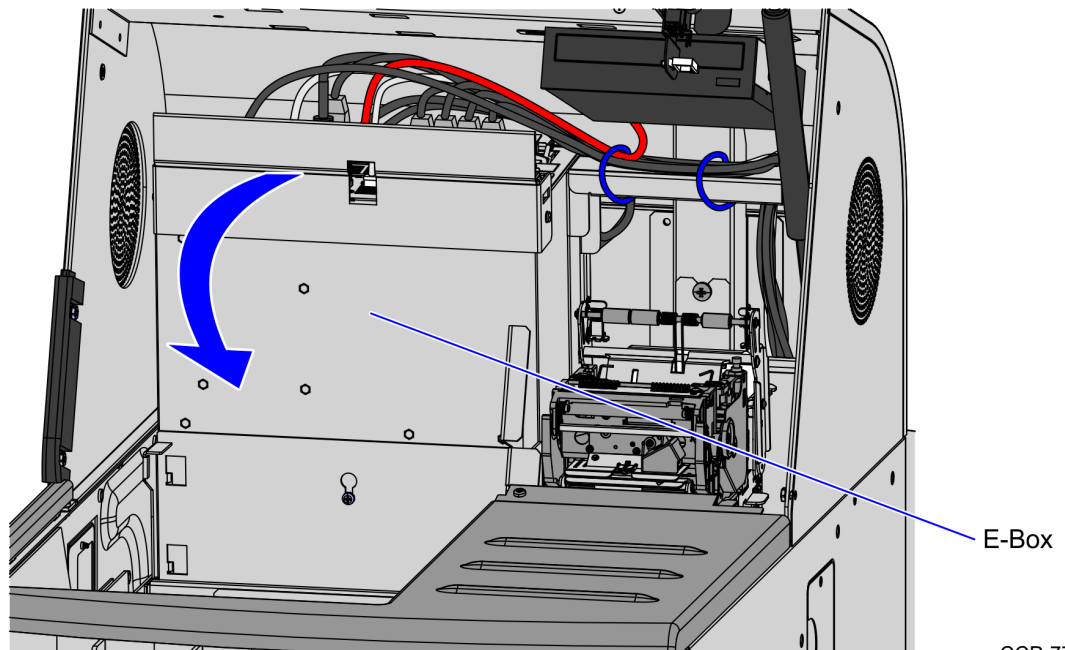

4. Detach the rear Core panel by removing six (6) screws to access the main cable bundle and Power Strip.

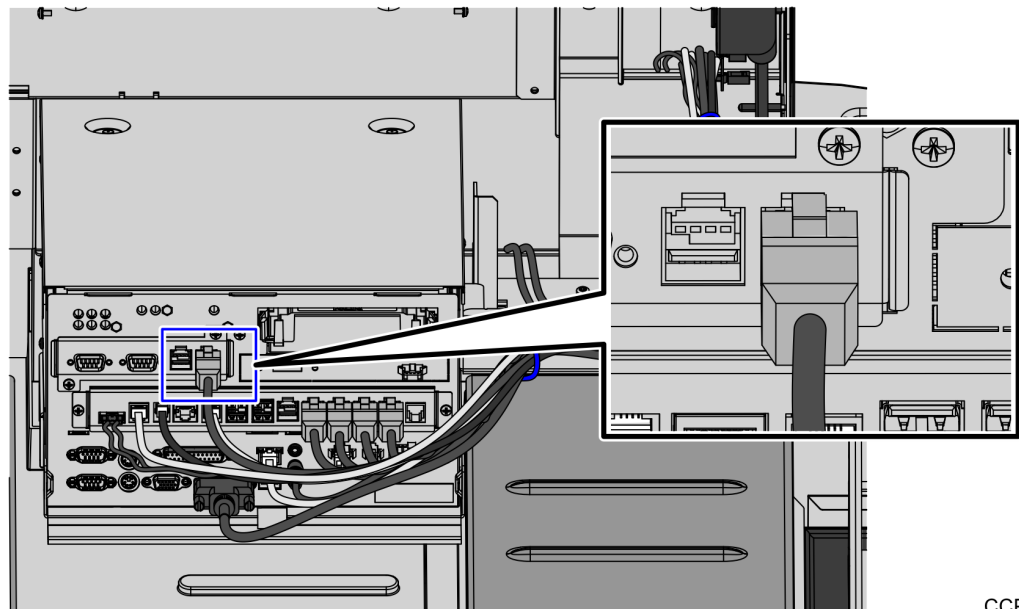

5. Tilt the E-Box Bracket forward to easily access the cables.



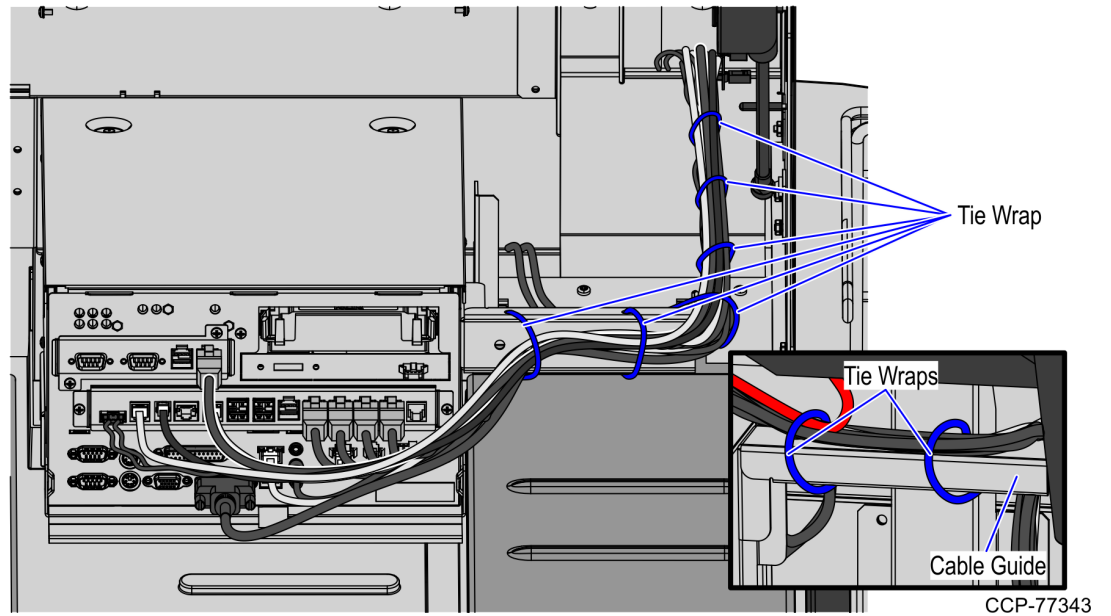
6. Unplug the pre-installed USB Power Cable from the Scale Controller in the new Bagwell and plug host connector to the USB M Port of the E-Box.



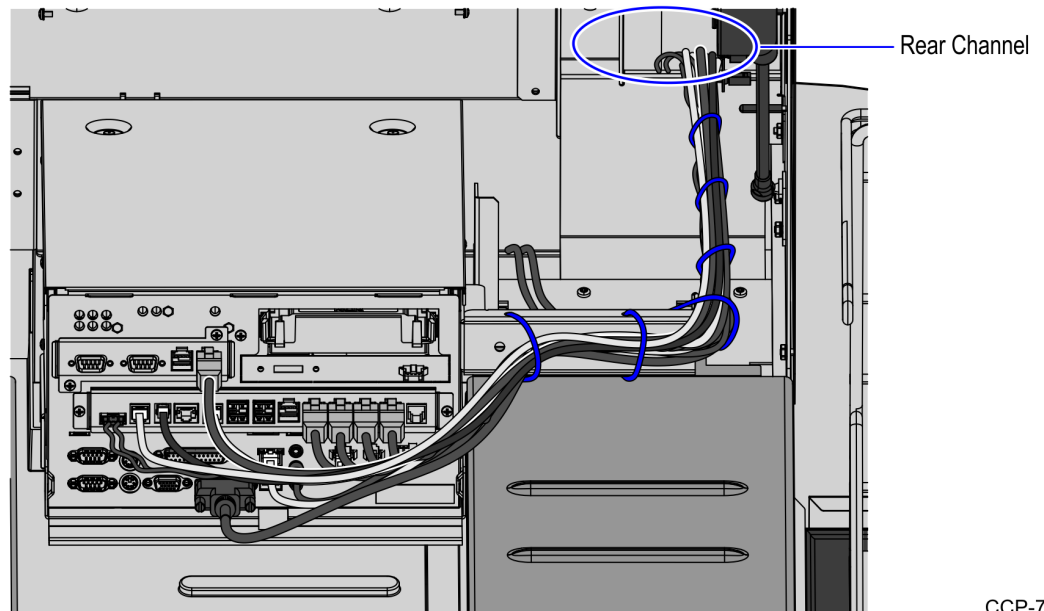
7. Tie the Scale Controller Cable to the main bundle by using six (6) cable ties.



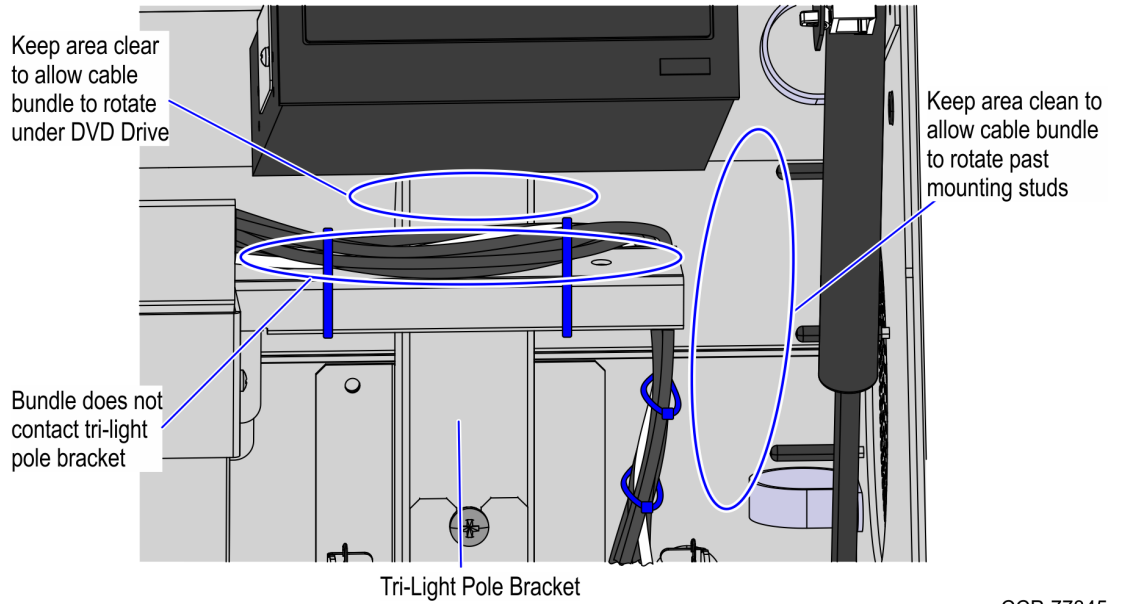
Note: Secure the main cable to the E-Box with the first two (2) cable ties.



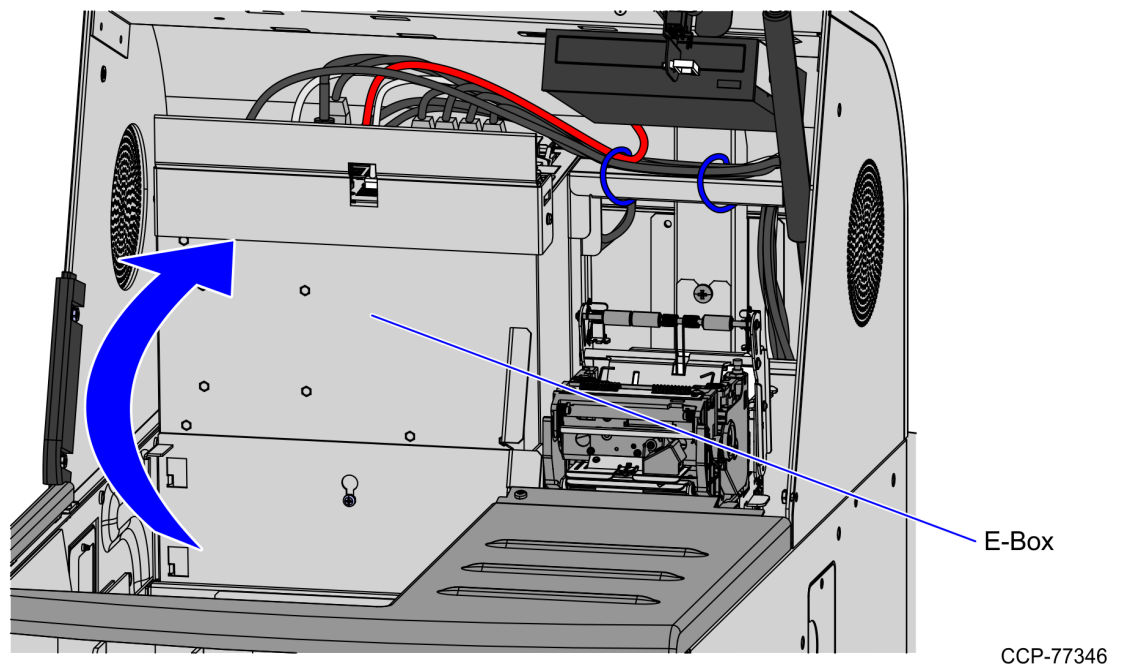
8. Continue routing the cable down the back of the Receipt Printer, as shown in the image below. Push all the cable slack to the rear of the Core.



9. Ensure that the cable bundle is not in contact with the Tri-Light pole bracket, DVD Drive, and ventilation fan studs when the E-Box is tilted from **Up** to **Down** positions as shown in the image below.




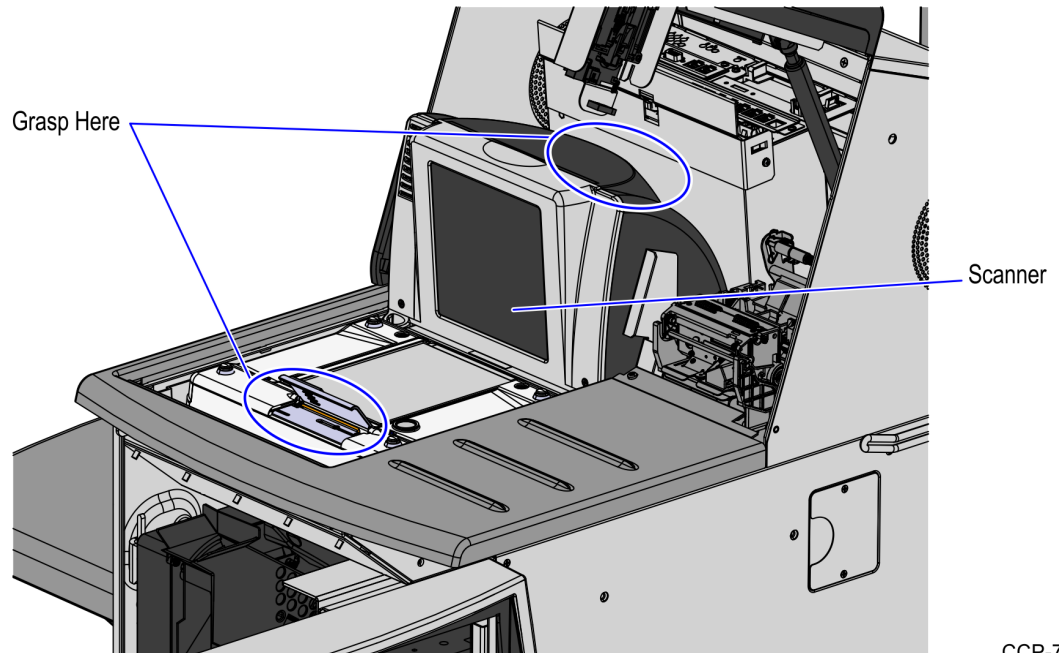
10. Rotate the E-Box back up. Help feed the cables down the back of the Receipt Printer to ensure that the cables are not tangled when the E-Box is rotated.



11. Install the Scanner/Scale. To install the Scanner/Scale, follow these steps:

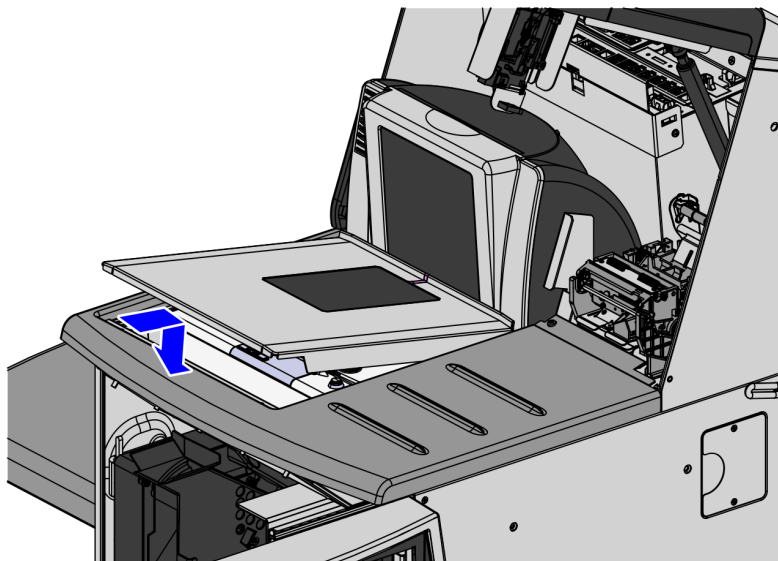
- a. Grasp the Scanner/Scale by its handles and lower it into the checkstand cutout.

 **Caution:** Be careful not to damage any of the cables.

- b. Place the back of Scanner/Scale on the two supports located on the E-Box mount.
- c. Lower the Scanner/Scale unto the scanner bucket area.
- d. Install the Scale Plate by placing it on top of the load cells.



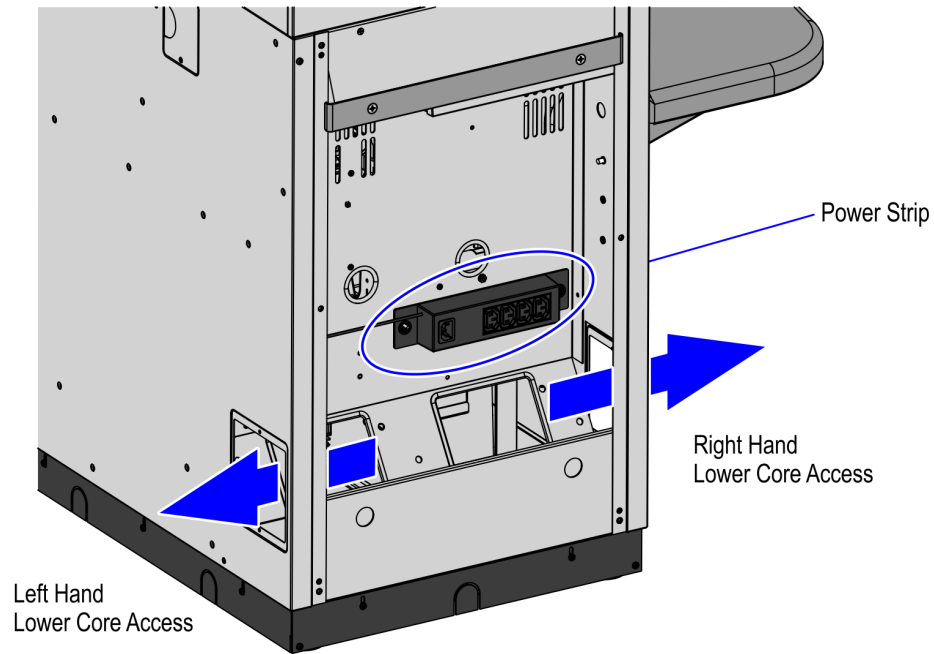

12. Ensure the E-Box can rotate freely by adjusting the position of the cable as needed. USB Power Cable should be routed through the left hand lower Core access cutout into the new Bagwell.

13. Unplug the AC Power Out and AC Power In cables from the Power Strip. AC Power In Cable will be reused in the new Bagwell. AC Power Out Cable should be routed either through the left-hand or right-hand lower Core access cutout into the new Bagwell.



Note: The Power Strip remains on the rear Core wall but not reused.
