
Changing the keys

To change the keys of the Security Door lock (Sargent and Greenleaf), follow these steps:

1. Open the Self-Checkout exterior door using a key.




2. Do the following:
 - a. On the Security Door, insert the Setup Key or the current Operating Key through the keyhole.
 - b. Turn the Security Doorknob counterclockwise, and then remove the key to open the Security Door.



3. Do the following:



- a. Locate the changing button on the back of the Security Door lock.



- b. Insert a probe into the changing button hole and keep the changing button pressed.


Note

The probe is not included in the 7360-K960 kit. Use any object that can fit into the changing hole (such as the tip of a ball point pen).

4. While keeping the changing button pressed, insert the existing key and turn it 180° clockwise until it reaches its stop.




5. Release the changing button and then remove the existing key.
6. Do the following:
 - a. Insert the new key into the keyhole.

Note

Ensure that the new key is fully engaged into the lock.

- b. Turn the new key 180° counter clockwise in a slow and deliberate motion (4-5 seconds) until it reaches its stop.



- c. Remove the new key.

7. Test the new key several times by opening the lock. Turn the key clockwise until it stops and then turn the knob.
8. Close the Security Door.
9. Turn the key counterclockwise and then remove it.
10. Close the Core Cabinet Door.
