


Installation Procedure


1. Lay the terminal face down on a flat surface.



Caution: Always use a soft material (cloth, foam) to protect the display screen when placing the terminal face down.


- 2. Remove the Rear Cover.

 - b. Pivot the Rear Cover as shown to remove it.


