Installation Procedures

1. Lay the terminal face down on a flat surface.

Caution: Always use a soft material (cloth, foam) to protect the display screen when placing the terminal face down.

2. Open the Cable Cover.



3. Remove two of the flat-head screws from the Display Cabinet as shown.

4. Install the Cable Security Bracket on the Display Cabinet using the M3x6 pan head screws (2) supplied in the kit.

5. Install the Cable Security Cover onto the Cable Security Bracket (2 flat-head screws).

- 6. Slide the Coil Springs (2) onto the shafts of the Captive Screws (2) and then screw the Captive Screws into the Cable Cover.
- **Note:** There are two sets of Captive Screws to choose from; one pair with regular Phillips heads or a pair with Torx heads, which provide additional security.



Cables are routed around the Cable Security Cover and out the Cable Cover opening.
