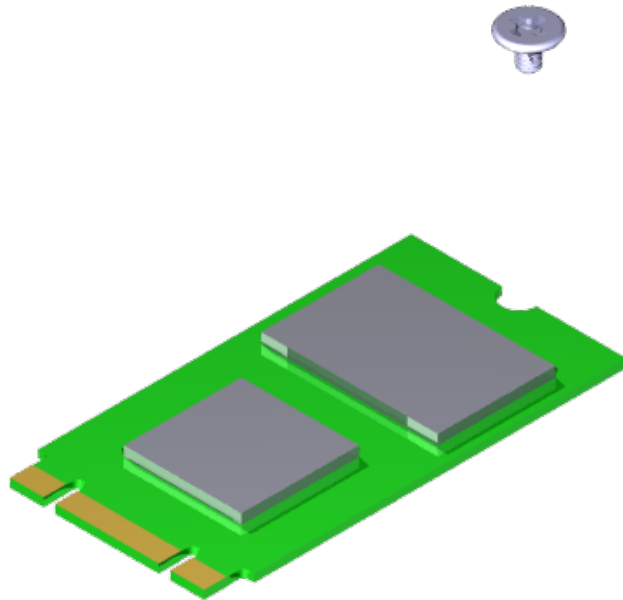

This kit provides a 128GB M.2 SSD for the NCR XR7 Plus POS.

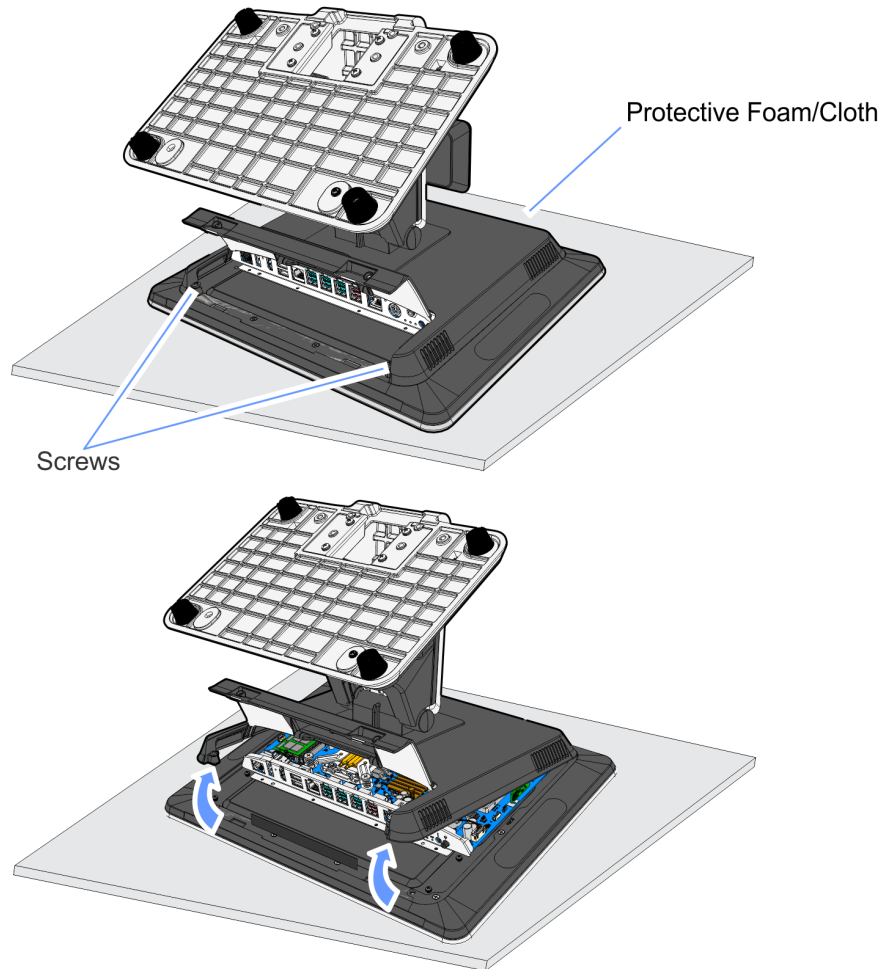


Installation Procedure

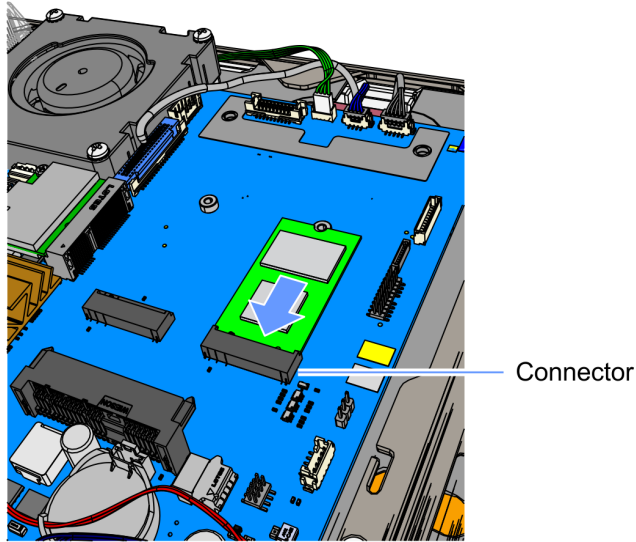
1. Lay the terminal face down on a flat surface.

 **Caution:** Always use a soft material (cloth, foam) to protect the display screen when placing the terminal face down.

2. Remove the Base Stand and Rear Cover assembly.
 - a. Loosen the captive screws (2) that secure the Rear Cover to the chassis.
 - b. Pivot the assembly as shown to remove it.

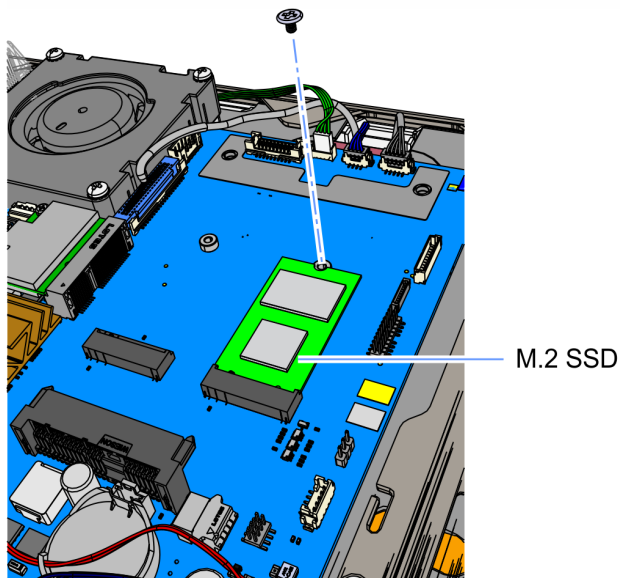


- Slide the M.2 SSD into an available connector on the Motherboard.



CCP-75493

- Secure the M.2 SSD to the Motherboard with the M2x3mm screw provided in the kit.



CCP-75494

- Replace the Base Stand and Rear Cover assembly on the terminal.
